courage against the <u>27\_DAN\_11\_25</u># And he shall stir up his power and his courage against the king of the south with a great army; and the king of the south shall be stirred up to battle with a very great and mighty army; but he shall not stand: for they shall forecast devices against him.

courage and bring <u>04\_NUM\_13\_20</u> # And what the land [is], whether it [be] fat or lean, whether there be wood therein, or not. And be ye of good courage, and bring of the fruit of the land. Now the time [was] the time of the firstripe grapes.

courage and do <u>13\_1CH\_28\_20</u> # And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do [it]: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, [even] my God, [will be] with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

courage and do <u>15\_EZR\_10\_04</u> # Arise; for [this] matter [belongeth] unto thee: we also [will be] with thee: be of good courage, and do [it].

courage and he <u>19\_PSA\_27\_14</u># Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

courage and he <u>19\_PSA\_31\_24</u># Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.

courage and let <u>13\_1CH\_19\_13</u># Be of good courage, and let us behave ourselves valiantly for our people, and for the cities of our God: and let the LORD do [that which is] good in his sight.

courage and let <u>10\_2SA\_10\_12</u> # Be of good courage, and let us play the men for our people, and for the cities of our God: and the LORD do that which seemeth him good.

courage and put <u>14\_2CH\_15\_08</u> # And when Asa heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, and put away the abominable idols out of all the land of Judah and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of the LORD, that [was] before the porch of the LORD.

courage be not <u>06\_JOS\_01\_09</u> # Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God [is] with thee whithersoever thou goest.

courage dread not <u>13\_1CH\_22\_13</u># Then shalt thou prosper, if thou takest heed to fulfil the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.

courage fear not <u>05\_DEU\_31\_06</u># Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he [it is] that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

courage for thou <u>05\_DEU\_31\_07</u> # And Moses called unto Joshua, and said unto him in the sight of all Israel, Be strong and of a good courage: for thou must go with this people unto the land which the LORD hath sworn unto their fathers to give them; and thou shalt cause them to inherit it.

courage for thou <u>05\_DEU\_31\_23</u># And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge, and said, Be strong and of a good courage: for thou shalt bring the children of Israel into the land which I sware unto them: and I will

be with thee.

courage for thus <u>06\_JOS\_10\_25</u> # And Joshua said unto them, Fear not, nor be dismayed, be strong and of good courage: for thus shall the LORD do to all your enemies against whom ye fight.

courage for unto <u>06\_JOS\_01\_06</u># Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give them.

courage in any <u>06\_JOS\_02\_11</u># And as soon as we had heard [these things], our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he [is] God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

courage <u>44\_ACT\_28\_15</u> # And from thence, when the brethren heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage.

courage <u>23\_ISA\_41\_06</u># They helped every one his neighbour; and [every one] said to his brother, Be of good courage.

courage <u>06\_JOS\_01\_18</u> # Whosoever [he be] that doth rebel against thy commandment, and will not hearken unto thy words in all that thou commandest him, he shall be put to death: only be strong and of a good courage.

courageous among the <u>30\_AMO\_02\_16</u># And [he that is] courageous among the mighty shall flee away naked in that day, saith the LORD.

courageous and be <u>10\_2SA\_13\_28</u># Now Absalom had commanded his servants, saying, Mark ye now when Amnon's heart is merry with wine, and when I say unto you, Smite Amnon; then kill him, fear not: have not I commanded you? be courageous, and be valiant.

courageous be not <u>14\_2CH\_32\_07</u># Be strong and courageous, be not afraid nor dismayed for the king of Assyria, nor for all the multitude that [is] with him: for [there be] more with us than with him:

courageous that thou <u>06\_JOS\_01\_07</u> # Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it [to] the right hand or [to] the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

courageous to keep <u>06\_JOS\_23\_06</u># Be ye therefore very courageous to keep and to do all that is written in the book of the law of Moses, that ye turn not aside therefrom [to] the right hand or [to] the left;

courageously and the <u>14\_2CH\_19\_11</u># And, behold, Amariah the chief priest [is] over you in all matters of the LORD; and Zebadiah the son of Ishmael, the ruler of the house of Judah, for all the king's matters: also the Levites [shall be] officers before you. Deal courageously, and the LORD shall be with the good.

discourage ye the <u>04\_NUM\_32\_07</u># And wherefore discourage ye the heart of the children of Israel from going over into the land which the LORD hath given them?

discouraged because of <u>04\_NUM\_21\_04</u> # And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and the soul of the people was much discouraged because of the way.

discouraged our heart <u>05\_DEU\_01\_28</u> # Whither shall we go up? our brethren have discouraged our heart, saying, The people [is] greater and taller than we; the cities [are] great and walled up to heaven; and moreover we have seen the sons of the Anakims there.

discouraged the heart <u>04\_NUM\_32\_09</u> # For when they went up unto the valley of Eshcol, and saw the land, they discouraged the heart of the children of Israel, that they should not go into the land which the LORD

had given them.

discouraged till he <u>23\_ISA\_42\_04</u> # He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for his law.

discouraged 51\_COL\_03\_21\_# Fathers, provoke not your children [to anger], lest they be discouraged.

discouraged <u>05\_DEU\_01\_21</u># Behold, the LORD thy God hath set the land before thee: go up [and] possess [it], as the LORD God of thy fathers hath said unto thee; fear not, neither be discouraged.

encourage him and <u>05\_DEU\_03\_28</u># But charge Joshua, and encourage him, and strengthen him: for he shall go over before this people, and he shall cause them to inherit the land which thou shalt see.

encourage him for <u>05\_DEU\_01\_38</u> # [But] Joshua the son of Nun, which standeth before thee, he shall go in thither: encourage him: for he shall cause Israel to inherit it.

encourage themselves in <u>19\_PSA\_64\_05</u># They encourage themselves [in] an evil matter: they commune of laying snares privily; they say, Who shall see them?

encourage thou him <u>10\_28A\_11\_25</u># Then David said unto the messenger, Thus shalt thou say unto Joab, Let not this thing displease thee, for the sword devoureth one as well as another: make thy battle more strong against the city, and overthrow it: and encourage thou him.

encouraged himself in <u>09\_1SA\_30\_06</u> # And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

encouraged in the <u>14\_2CH\_31\_04</u> # Moreover he commanded the people that dwelt in Jerusalem to give the portion of the priests and the Levites, that they might be encouraged in the law of the LORD.

encouraged the goldsmith <u>23\_ISA\_41\_07</u># So the carpenter encouraged the goldsmith, [and] he that smootheth [with] the hammer him that smote the anvil, saying, It [is] ready for the soldering: and he fastened it with nails, [that] it should not be moved.

encouraged them to <u>14\_2CH\_35\_02</u> # And he set the priests in their charges, and encouraged them to the service of the house of the LORD,

encouraged themselves and <u>07\_JUD\_20\_22</u># And the people the men of Israel encouraged themselves, and set their battle again in array in the place where they put themselves in array the first day.

ossifrage and the <u>05\_DEU\_14\_12</u># But these [are they] of which ye shall not eat: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the osprey,

ossifrage and the <u>03\_LEV\_11\_13</u># And these [are they which] ye shall have in abomination among the fowls; they shall not be eaten, they [are] an abomination: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the osprey,

outrageous but who 20\_PRO\_27\_04 # Wrath [is] cruel, and anger [is] outrageous; but who [is] able to stand before envy?

rage against me <u>12\_2KI\_19\_27</u># But I know thy abode, and thy going out, and thy coming in, and thy rage against me.

rage against me <u>12\_2KI\_19\_28</u> # Because thy rage against me and thy tumult is come up into mine ears, therefore I will put my hook in thy nose, and my bridle in thy lips, and I will turn thee back by the way by which thou camest.

rage against me 23\_ISA\_37\_28 # But I know thy abode, and thy going out, and thy coming in, and thy rage against me.

rage against me <u>23\_ISA\_37\_29</u> # Because thy rage against me, and thy tumult, is come up into mine ears, therefore will I put my hook in thy nose, and my bridle in thy lips, and I will turn thee back by the way by which thou camest.

rage and fury <u>27\_DAN\_03\_13</u># Then Nebuchadnezzar in [his] rage and fury commanded to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Then they brought these men before the king.

rage and the <u>44\_ACT\_04\_25</u> # Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things?

rage and the <u>19\_PSA\_02\_01</u># Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?

rage in the <u>34\_NAH\_02\_04</u> # The chariots shall rage in the streets, they shall justle one against another in the broad ways: they shall seem like torches, they shall run like the lightnings.

rage neither believeth <u>18\_JOB\_39\_24</u> # He swalloweth the ground with fierceness and rage: neither believeth he that [it is] the sound of the trumpet.

rage of a <u>20\_PRO\_06\_34</u># For jealousy [is] the rage of a man: therefore he will not spare in the day of vengeance.

rage of mine <u>19\_PSA\_07\_06</u># Arise, O LORD, in thine anger, lift up thyself because of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me [to] the judgment [that] thou hast commanded.

rage of their <u>28\_HOS\_07\_16</u># They return, [but] not to the most High: they are like a deceitful bow: their princes shall fall by the sword for the rage of their tongue: this [shall be] their derision in the land of Egypt.

rage of thy <u>18\_JOB\_40\_11</u># Cast abroad the rage of thy wrath: and behold every one [that is] proud, and abase him.

rage or laugh <u>20\_PRO\_29\_09</u> # [If] a wise man contendeth with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, [there is] no rest.

rage that reacheth <u>14\_2CH\_28\_09</u> # But a prophet of the LORD was there, whose name [was] Oded: and he went out before the host that came to Samaria, and said unto them, Behold, because the LORD God of your fathers was wroth with Judah, he hath delivered them into your hand, and ye have slain them in a rage [that] reacheth up unto heaven.

rage with him <u>14\_2CH\_16\_10</u> # Then Asa was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house; for [he was] in a rage with him because of this [thing]. And Asa oppressed [some] of the people the same time.

rage ye chariots <u>24\_JER\_46\_09</u> # Come up, ye horses; and rage, ye chariots; and let the mighty men come forth; the Ethiopians and the Libyans, that handle the shield; and the Lydians, that handle [and] bend the bow.

rage <u>12\_2KI\_05\_12</u> # [Are] not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage.

raged the kingdoms <u>19\_PSA\_46\_06</u># The heathen raged, the kingdoms were moved: he uttered his voice, the earth melted.

Page 5 rageth and is <u>20\_PRO\_14\_16</u># A wise [man] feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.
