Ramah and Bethel <u>07\_JUD\_04\_05</u> # And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.

Ramah and came <u>09\_1SA\_19\_22</u># Then went he also to Ramah, and came to a great well that [is] in Sechu: and he asked and said, Where [are] Samuel and David? And [one] said, Behold, [they be] at Naioth in Ramah.

Ramah and Hazor 06\_JOS\_19\_36 # And Adamah, and Ramah, and Hazor,

Ramah and let 14\_2CH\_16\_05 # And it came to pass, when Baasha heard [it], that he left off building of Ramah, and let his work cease.

Ramah is afraid <u>23\_ISA\_10\_29</u> # They are gone over the passage: they have taken up their lodging at Geba; Ramah is afraid; Gibeah of Saul is fled.
