reaper and the <u>30\_AMO\_09\_13</u># Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

reapers among the <u>08\_RUT\_02\_07</u># And she said, I pray you, let me glean and gather after the reapers among the sheaves: so she came, and hath continued even from the morning until now, that she tarried a little in the house.

reapers and he <u>08\_RUT\_02\_14</u># And Boaz said unto her, At mealtime come thou hither, and eat of the bread, and dip thy morsel in the vinegar. And she sat beside the reapers: and he reached her parched [corn], and she did eat, and was sufficed, and left.

reapers and her <u>08\_RUT\_02\_03</u> # And she went, and came, and gleaned in the field after the reapers: and her hap was to light on a part of the field [belonging] unto Boaz, who [was] of the kindred of Elimelech.

reapers answered and <u>08\_RUT\_02\_06</u># And the servant that was set over the reapers answered and said, It [is] the Moabitish damsel that came back with Naomi out of the country of Moab:

reapers are the <u>40\_MAT\_13\_39</u># The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

reapers Gather ye <u>40\_MAT\_13\_30</u># Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

reapers The LORD <u>08\_RUT\_02\_04</u># And, behold, Boaz came from Bethlehem, and said unto the reapers, The LORD [be] with you. And they answered him, The LORD bless thee.

reapers Whose damsel <u>08\_RUT\_02\_05</u> # Then said Boaz unto his servant that was set over the reapers, Whose damsel [is] this?

reapers 12\_2KI\_04\_18 # And when the child was grown, it fell on a day, that he went out to his father to the reapers.
