rebuke a wise <u>20\_PRO\_09\_08</u># Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate thee: rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee.

rebuke among the <u>28\_HOS\_05\_09</u> # Ephraim shall be desolate in the day of rebuke: among the tribes of Israel have I made known that which shall surely be.

rebuke and blasphemy <u>12\_2KI\_19\_03</u> # And they said unto him, Thus saith Hezekiah, This day [is] a day of trouble, and of rebuke, and blasphemy: for the children are come to the birth, and [there is] not strength to bring forth.

rebuke and chasten <u>66\_REV\_03\_19</u># As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

rebuke and of <u>23\_ISA\_37\_03</u># And they said unto him, Thus saith Hezekiah, This day [is] a day of trouble, and of rebuke, and of blasphemy: for the children are come to the birth, and [there is] not strength to bring forth.
