reconcile all things [51 COL 01 20](#) # And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, [I say], whether [they be] things in earth, or things in heaven.

reconcile both unto [49 EPH 02 16](#) # And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

reconcile himself unto [09 ISA 29 04](#) # And the princes of the Philistines were wroth with him; and the princes of the Philistines said unto him, Make this fellow return, that he may go again to his place which thou hast appointed him, and let him not go down with us to battle, lest in the battle he be an adversary to us: for wherewith should he reconcile himself unto his master? [should it] not [be] with the heads of these men?

reconcile the house [26 EZE 45 20](#) # And so thou shalt do the seventh [day] of the month for every one that erreth, and for [him that is] simple: so shall ye reconcile the house.

reconcile withal in [03 LEV 06 30](#) # And no sin offering, whereof [any] of the blood is brought into the tabernacle of the congregation to reconcile [withal] in the holy [place], shall be eaten: it shall be burnt in the fire.

reconciled to God [47 2CO 05 20](#) # Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech [you] by us: we pray [you] in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

reconciled to God [45 ROM 05 10](#) # For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

reconciled to her [46 1CO 07 11](#) # But and if she depart, let her remain unmarried, or be reconciled to [her] husband: and let not the husband put away [his] wife.

reconciled to thy [40 MAT 05 24](#) # Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

reconciled us to [47 2CO 05 18](#) # And all things [are] of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;
