agreed already that [43 JOH 09 22](#) # These [words] spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue.

agreed and when [44 ACT 05 40](#) # And to him they agreed: and when they had called the apostles, and beaten [them], they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.

agreed not among [44 ACT 28 25](#) # And when they agreed not among themselves, they departed, after that Paul had spoken one word, Well spake the Holy Ghost by Esaias the prophet unto our fathers,

agreed not together [41 MAR 14 56](#) # For many bare false witness against him, but their witness agreed not together.

agreed to desire [44 ACT 23 20](#) # And he said, The Jews have agreed to desire thee that thou wouldest bring down Paul to morrow into the council, as though they would inquire somewhat of him more perfectly.

agreed together to [44 ACT 05 09](#) # Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband [are] at the door, and shall carry thee out.

agreed with the [40 MAT 20 02](#) # And when he had agreed with the labourers for a penny a day, he sent them into his vineyard.

agreed [30 AMO 03 03](#) # Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

breed abundantly in [01 GEN 08 17](#) # Bring forth with thee every living thing that [is] with thee, of all flesh, [both] of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply upon the earth.

breed of Bashan [05 DEU 32 14](#) # Butter of kine, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the fat of kidneys of wheat; and thou didst drink the pure blood of the grape.

breeding of nettles [36 ZEP 02 09](#) # Therefore [as] I live, saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Surely Moab shall be as Sodom, and the children of Ammon as Gomorrah, [even] the breeding of nettles, and saltpits, and a perpetual desolation: the residue of my people shall spoil them, and the remnant of my people shall possess them.

decreed against her [17 EST 02 01](#) # After these things, when the wrath of king Ahasuerus was appeased, he remembered Vashti, and what she had done, and what was decreed against her.

decreed for themselves [17 EST 09 31](#) # To confirm these days of Purim in their times [appointed], according as Mordecai the Jew and Esther the queen had enjoined them, and as they had decreed for themselves and for their seed, the matters of the fastings and their cry.

decreed in his [46 1CO 07 37](#) # Nevertheless he that standeth stedfast in his heart, having no necessity, but hath power over his own will, and hath so decreed in his heart that he will keep his virgin, doeth well.

decreed place and [18 JOB 38 10](#) # And brake up for it my decreed [place], and set bars and doors,

decreed shall overflow [23 ISA 10 22](#) # For though thy people Israel be as the sand of the sea, [yet] a remnant of them shall return: the consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness.

freed from being [06 JOS 09 23](#) # Now therefore ye [are] cursed, and there shall none of you be freed from being bondmen, and hewers of wood and drawers of water for the house of my God.

freed from sin [45 ROM 06 07](#) # For he that is dead is freed from sin.

freedom And Paul [44 ACT 22 28](#) # And the chief captain answered, With a great sum obtained I this freedom. And Paul said, But I was [free] born.

freedom given her [03 LEV 19 20](#) # And whosoever lieth carnally with a woman, that [is] a bondmaid, betrothed to an husband, and not at all redeemed, nor freedom given her; she shall be scourged; they shall not be put to death, because she was not free.

greedily after the [65 JDE 01 11](#) # Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

greedily all the [20 PRO 21 26](#) # He coveteth greedily all the day long: but the righteous giveth and spareth not.

greedily gained of [26 EZE 22 12](#) # In thee have they taken gifts to shed blood; thou hast taken usury and increase, and thou hast greedily gained of thy neighbours by extortion, and hast forgotten me, saith the Lord GOD.

greediness [49 EPH 04 19](#) # Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

greedy dogs which [23 ISA 56 11](#) # Yea, [they are] greedy dogs [which] can never have enough, and they [are] shepherds [that] cannot understand: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter.

greedy of filthy [54 1TI 03 03](#) # Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;

greedy of filthy [54 1TI 03 08](#) # Likewise [must] the deacons [be] grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre;

greedy of gain [20 PRO 01 19](#) # So [are] the ways of every one that is greedy of gain; [which] taketh away the life of the owners thereof.

greedy of gain [20 PRO 15 27](#) # He that is greedy of gain troubleth his own house; but he that hateth gifts shall live.

greedy of his [19 PSA 17 12](#) # Like as a lion [that] is greedy of his prey, and as it were a young lion lurking in secret places.

reed and did [41 MAR 15 19](#) # And they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing [their] knees worshipped him.

reed and fens [18 JOB 40 21](#) # He lieth under the shady trees, in the covert of the reed, and fens.

reed and gave [41 MAR 15 36](#) # And one ran and filled a sponge full of vinegar, and put [it] on a reed, and

gave him to drink, saying, Let alone; let us see whether Elias will come to take him down.

reed and gave [40 MAT 27 48](#) # And straightway one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled [it] with vinegar, and put [it] on a reed, and gave him to drink.

reed and he [26 EZE 40 03](#) # And he brought me thither, and, behold, [there was] a man, whose appearance [was] like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

reed shall he [23 ISA 42 03](#) # A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.

reed shall he [40 MAT 12 20](#) # A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory.

reed to measure [66 REV 21 15](#) # And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.

reed to the [26 EZE 29 06](#) # And all the inhabitants of Egypt shall know that I [am] the LORD, because they have been a staff of reed to the house of Israel.

reed twelve thousand [66 REV 21 16](#) # And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.
