refuse and rebel <u>23\_ISA\_01\_20</u> # But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken [it].

refuse for when <u>54\_1TI\_05\_11</u># But the younger widows refuse: for when they have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they will marry;

refuse in the <u>25\_LAM\_03\_45</u># Thou hast made us [as] the offscouring and refuse in the midst of the people.

refuse it not 20\_PRO\_08\_33 # Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.

refuse not him <u>58\_HEB\_12\_25</u> # See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more [shall not] we [escape], if we turn away from him that [speaketh] from heaven:

refuse not to <u>44\_ACT\_25\_11</u># For if I be an offender, or have committed any thing worthy of death, I refuse not to die: but if there be none of these things whereof these accuse me, no man may deliver me unto them. I appeal unto Caesar.

refuse of the <u>30\_AMO\_08\_06</u> # That we may buy the poor for silver, and the needy for a pair of shoes; [yea], and sell the refuse of the wheat?

refuse or whether <u>18\_JOB\_34\_33</u> # [Should it be] according to thy mind? he will recompense it, whether thou refuse, or whether thou choose; and not I: therefore speak what thou knowest.

refuse profane and <u>54\_1TI\_04\_07</u> # But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself [rather] unto godliness.

refuse that they <u>09\_1SA\_15\_09</u> # But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all [that was] good, and would not utterly destroy them: but every thing [that was] vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

refuse the evil <u>23\_ISA\_07\_15</u> # Butter and honey shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil, and choose the good.

refuse the evil <u>23\_ISA\_07\_16</u># For before the child shall know to refuse the evil, and choose the good, the land that thou abhorrest shall be forsaken of both her kings.

refuse to do <u>20\_PRO\_21\_07</u># The robbery of the wicked shall destroy them; because they refuse to do judgment.

refuse to give <u>02\_EXO\_22\_17</u> # If her father utterly refuse to give her unto him, he shall pay money according to the dowry of virgins.

refuse to go 24\_JER\_38\_21 # But if thou refuse to go forth, this [is] the word that the LORD hath showed me:

refuse to hear <u>24\_JER\_13\_10</u> # This evil people, which refuse to hear my words, which walk in the imagination of their heart, and walk after other gods, to serve them, and to worship them, shall even be as

this girdle, which is good for nothing.

refuse to humble <u>02\_EXO\_10\_03</u># And Moses and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, How long wilt thou refuse to humble thyself before me? let my people go, that they may serve me.

refuse to know <u>24\_JER\_09\_06</u># Thine habitation [is] in the midst of deceit; through deceit they refuse to know me, saith the LORD.

refuse to labour <u>20\_PRO\_21\_25</u> # The desire of the slothful killeth him; for his hands refuse to labour.

refuse to let <u>02\_EXO\_04\_23</u> # And I say unto thee, Let my son go, that he may serve me: and if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, [even] thy firstborn.

refuse to let <u>02\_EXO\_08\_02</u># And if thou refuse to let [them] go, behold, I will smite all thy borders with frogs:

refuse to let <u>02\_EXO\_09\_02</u># For if thou refuse to let [them] go, and wilt hold them still,

refuse to let <u>02\_EXO\_10\_04</u># Else, if thou refuse to let my people go, behold, to morrow will I bring the locusts into thy coast:

refuse to return <u>24\_JER\_08\_05</u> # Why [then] is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return.

refuse to take <u>24\_JER\_25\_28</u># And it shall be, if they refuse to take the cup at thine hand to drink, then shalt thou say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Ye shall certainly drink.

refuse ye to <u>02\_EXO\_16\_28</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, How long refuse ye to keep my commandments and my laws?

refused and said <u>09\_1SA\_28\_23</u># But he refused, and said, I will not eat. But his servants, together with the woman, compelled him; and he hearkened unto their voice. So he arose from the earth, and sat upon the bed.

refused and said <u>01\_GEN\_39\_08</u># But he refused, and said unto his master's wife, Behold, my master wotteth not what [is] with me in the house, and he hath committed all that he hath to my hand;

refused and said <u>01\_GEN\_48\_19</u> # And his father refused, and said, I know [it], my son, I know [it]: he also shall become a people, and he also shall be great: but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his seed shall become a multitude of nations.

refused him for <u>09\_1SA\_16\_07</u> # But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for [the LORD seeth] not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.

refused him that <u>58\_HEB\_12\_25</u> # See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more [shall not] we [escape], if we turn away from him that [speaketh] from heaven:

refused I have <u>20\_PRO\_01\_24</u># Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded;

refused if it <u>54\_1TI\_04\_04</u> # For every creature of God [is] good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

refused is become <u>19\_PSA\_118\_22</u># The stone [which] the builders refused is become the head [stone] of the corner.

refused my judgments <u>26\_EZE\_05\_06</u> # And she hath changed my judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and my statutes more than the countries that [are] round about her: for they have refused my judgments and my statutes, they have not walked in them.

refused saith thy <u>23\_ISA\_54\_06</u> # For the LORD hath called thee as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when thou wast refused, saith thy God.

refused saying Who <u>44\_ACT\_07\_35</u> # This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did God send [to be] a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush.

refused the tabernacle <u>19\_PSA\_78\_67</u># Moreover he refused the tabernacle of Joseph, and chose not the tribe of Ephraim:

refused to be <u>01\_GEN\_37\_35</u># And all his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him; but he refused to be comforted; and he said, For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning. Thus his father wept for him.

refused to be <u>58\_HEB\_11\_24</u># By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

refused to be <u>24\_JER\_31\_15</u># Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, [and] bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they [were] not.

refused to be <u>19\_PSA\_77\_02</u># In the day of my trouble I sought the Lord: my sore ran in the night, and ceased not: my soul refused to be comforted.

refused to come <u>17\_EST\_01\_12</u> # But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by [his] chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

refused to eat <u>10\_28A\_13\_09</u># And she took a pan, and poured [them] out before him; but he refused to eat. And Amnon said, Have out all men from me. And they went out every man from him.

refused to give <u>11\_1KI\_21\_15</u># And it came to pass, when Jezebel heard that Naboth was stoned, and was dead, that Jezebel said to Ahab, Arise, take possession of the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give thee for money: for Naboth is not alive, but dead.

refused to give <u>04\_NUM\_20\_21</u># Thus Edom refused to give Israel passage through his border: wherefore Israel turned away from him.

refused to hear <u>24\_JER\_11\_10</u># They are turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers, which refused to hear my words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant which I made with their fathers.

refused to hearken <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_11</u># But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear.

refused to let <u>24\_JER\_50\_33</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

refused to obey <u>09\_1SA\_08\_19</u> # Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us;

refused to obey <u>16\_NEH\_09\_17</u> # And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

refused to receive <u>24\_JER\_05\_03</u> # O LORD, [are] not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, [but] they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.

refused to return <u>28\_HOS\_11\_05</u># He shall not return into the land of Egypt, but the Assyrian shall be his king, because they refused to return.

refused to return <u>24\_JER\_05\_03</u> # O LORD, [are] not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, [but] they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.

refused to smite <u>11\_1KI\_20\_35</u># And a certain man of the sons of the prophets said unto his neighbour in the word of the LORD, Smite me, I pray thee. And the man refused to smite him.

refused to touch <u>18\_JOB\_06\_07</u># The things [that] my soul refused to touch [are] as my sorrowful meat.

refused to turn <u>10\_2SA\_02\_23</u> # Howbeit he refused to turn aside: wherefore Abner with the hinder end of the spear smote him under the fifth [rib], that the spear came out behind him; and he fell down there, and died in the same place: and it came to pass, [that] as many as came to the place where Asahel fell down and died stood still.

refused to walk <u>19\_PSA\_78\_10</u> # They kept not the covenant of God, and refused to walk in his law;

refused <u>12\_2KI\_05\_16</u># But he said, [As] the LORD liveth, before whom I stand, I will receive none. And he urged him to take [it]; but he refused.

refusedst to be <u>24\_JER\_03\_03</u># Therefore the showers have been withholden, and there hath been no latter rain; and thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed.

refuseth instruction but <u>20\_PRO\_13\_18</u># Poverty and shame [shall be to] him that refuseth instruction: but he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.

refuseth instruction despiseth <u>20\_PRO\_15\_32</u># He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul: but he that heareth reproof getteth understanding.

refuseth reproof erreth <u>20\_PRO\_10\_17</u># He [is in] the way of life that keepeth instruction: but he that refuseth reproof erreth.

refuseth the waters <u>23\_ISA\_08\_06</u> # Forasmuch as this people refuseth the waters of Shiloah that go softly, and rejoice in Rezin and Remaliah's son;

refuseth to be <u>24\_JER\_15\_18</u> # Why is my pain perpetual, and my wound incurable, [which] refuseth to be healed? wilt thou be altogether unto me as a liar, [and as] waters [that] fail?

refuseth to come <u>04\_NUM\_22\_14</u> # And the princes of Moab rose up, and they went unto Balak, and said, Balaam refuseth to come with us.

refuseth to give <u>04\_NUM\_22\_13</u> # And Balaam rose up in the morning, and said unto the princes of Balak, Get you into your land: for the LORD refuseth to give me leave to go with you.

refuseth to let <u>02\_EXO\_07\_14</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart [is] hardened, he refuseth to let the people go.

refuseth to raise <u>05\_DEU\_25\_07</u> # And if the man like not to take his brother's wife, then let his brother's wife go up to the gate unto the elders, and say, My husband's brother refuseth to raise up unto his brother a name in Israel, he will not perform the duty of my husband's brother.
