roar after their [19 PSA 104 21](#) # The young lions roar after their prey, and seek their meat from God.

roar against them [23 ISA 05 30](#) # And in that day they shall roar against them like the roaring of the sea: and if [one] look unto the land, behold darkness [and] sorrow, and the light is darkened in the heavens thereof.

roar all like [23 ISA 59 11](#) # We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for judgment, but [there is] none; for salvation, [but] it is far off from us.

roar and be [19 PSA 46 03](#) # [Though] the waters thereof roar [and] be troubled, [though] the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

roar and lay [23 ISA 05 29](#) # Their roaring [shall be] like a lion, they shall roar like young lions: yea, they shall roar, and lay hold of the prey, and shall carry [it] away safe, and none shall deliver [it].

roar and the [13 1CH 16 32](#) # Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields rejoice, and all that [is] therein.

roar and the [19 PSA 96 11](#) # Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof.

roar and the [19 PSA 98 07](#) # Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

roar from on [24 JER 25 30](#) # Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread [the grapes], against all the inhabitants of the earth.

roar from Zion [30 AMO 01 02](#) # And he said, The LORD will roar from Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither.

roar he shall [23 ISA 42 13](#) # The LORD shall go forth as a mighty man, he shall stir up jealousy like a man of war: he shall cry, yea, roar; he shall prevail against his enemies.

roar in the [30 AMO 03 04](#) # Will a lion roar in the forest, when he hath no prey? will a young lion cry out of his den, if he have taken nothing?

roar in the [19 PSA 74 04](#) # Thine enemies roar in the midst of thy congregations; they set up their ensigns [for] signs.

roar like a [28 HOS 11 10](#) # They shall walk after the LORD: he shall roar like a lion: when he shall roar, then the children shall tremble from the west.

roar like great [24 JER 51 55](#) # Because the LORD hath spoiled Babylon, and destroyed out of her the great voice; when her waves do roar like great waters, a noise of their voice is uttered:

roar like the [24 JER 50 42](#) # They shall hold the bow and the lance: they [are] cruel, and will not show

mercy: their voice shall roar like the sea, and they shall ride upon horses, [every one] put in array, like a man to the battle, against thee, O daughter of Babylon.

roar like young [23 ISA 05 29](#) # Their roaring [shall be] like a lion, they shall roar like young lions: yea, they shall roar, and lay hold of the prey, and shall carry [it] away safe, and none shall deliver [it].

roar out of [29 JOE 03 16](#) # The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD [will be] the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.

roared against him [07 JUD 14 05](#) # Then went Samson down, and his father and his mother, to Timnath, and came to the vineyards of Timnath: and, behold, a young lion roared against him.

roared by reason [19 PSA 38 08](#) # I am feeble and sore broken: I have roared by reason of the disquietness of my heart.

roared The LORD [23 ISA 51 15](#) # But I [am] the LORD thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts [is] his name.

roared upon him [24 JER 02 15](#) # The young lions roared upon him, [and] yelled, and they made his land waste: his cities are burned without inhabitant.

roared who will [30 AMO 03 08](#) # The lion hath roared, who will not fear? the Lord GOD hath spoken, who can but prophesy?

roareth and when [66 REV 10 03](#) # And cried with a loud voice, as [when] a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

roareth he thundereth [18 JOB 37 04](#) # After it a voice roareth: he thundereth with the voice of his excellency; and he will not stay them when his voice is heard.

roareth like the [24 JER 06 23](#) # They shall lay hold on bow and spear; they [are] cruel, and have no mercy; their voice roareth like the sea; and they ride upon horses, set in array as men for war against thee, O daughter of Zion.

roaring all the [19 PSA 32 03](#) # When I kept silence, my bones waxed old through my roaring all the day long.

roaring lion and [20 PRO 28 15](#) # [As] a roaring lion, and a ranging bear; [so is] a wicked ruler over the poor people.

roaring lion ravening [26 EZE 22 25](#) # [There is] a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst thereof, like a roaring lion ravening the prey; they have devoured souls; they have taken the treasure and precious things; they have made her many widows in the midst thereof.

roaring lion walketh [60 1PE 05 08](#) # Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

roaring lion [19 PSA 22 13](#) # They gaped upon me [with] their mouths, [as] a ravening and a roaring lion.

roaring lions her [36 ZEP 03 03](#) # Her princes within her [are] roaring lions; her judges [are] evening wolves; they gnaw not the bones till the morrow.

roaring of a [20 PRO 19 12](#) # The king's wrath [is] as the roaring of a lion; but his favour [is] as dew upon the grass.

roaring of a [20 PRO 20 02](#) # The fear of a king [is] as the roaring of a lion: [whoso] provoketh him to anger sinneth [against] his own soul.

roaring of the [23 ISA 05 30](#) # And in that day they shall roar against them like the roaring of the sea: and if [one] look unto the land, behold darkness [and] sorrow, and the light is darkened in the heavens thereof.

roaring of the [18 JOB 04 10](#) # The roaring of the lion, and the voice of the fierce lion, and the teeth of the young lions, are broken.

roaring of young [38 ZEC 11 03](#) # [There is] a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the pride of Jordan is spoiled.

roaring on his [23 ISA 31 04](#) # For thus hath the LORD spoken unto me, Like as the lion and the young lion roaring on his prey, when a multitude of shepherds is called forth against him, [he] will not be afraid of their voice, nor abase himself for the noise of them: so shall the LORD of hosts come down to fight for mount Zion, and for the hill thereof.

roarings are poured [18 JOB 03 24](#) # For my sighing cometh before I eat, and my roarings are poured out like the waters.

uproar among the [40 MAT 26 05](#) # But they said, Not on the feast [day], lest there be an uproar among the people.

uproar and assaulted [44 ACT 17 05](#) # But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them

**certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people.**

**uproar and leddest [44 ACT 21 38](#) # Art not thou that Egyptian, which before these days madest an uproar, and leddest out into the wilderness four thousand men that were murderers?**

**uproar of the [41 MAR 14 02](#) # But they said, Not on the feast [day], lest there be an uproar of the people.**

**uproar there being [44 ACT 19 40](#) # For we are in danger to be called in question for this day's uproar, there being no cause whereby we may give an account of this concourse.**

**uproar was ceased [44 ACT 20 01](#) # And after the uproar was ceased, Paul called unto [him] the disciples, and embraced [them], and departed for to go into Macedonia.**

**uproar [11 1KI 01 41](#) # And Adonijah and all the guests that [were] with him heard [it] as they had made an end of eating. And when Joab heard the sound of the trumpet, he said, Wherefore [is this] noise of the city being in an uproar?**

**uproar [44 ACT 21 31](#) # And as they went about to kill him, tidings came unto the chief captain of the band, that all Jerusalem was in an uproar.**
