Arodites of Areli 04\_NUM\_26\_17 # Of Arod, the family of the Arodites: of Areli, the family of the Arelites.

Berodachbaladan the son 12 2KI 20 12 # At that time Berodachbaladan, the son of Baladan, king of Babylon, sent letters and a present unto Hezekiah: for he had heard that Hezekiah had been sick.

emerods and five <u>09\_1SA\_06\_04</u> # Then said they, What [shall be] the trespass offering which we shall return to him? They answered, Five golden emerods, and five golden mice, [according to] the number of the lords of the Philistines: for one plague [was] on you all, and on your lords.

Harod so that <u>07\_JUD\_07\_01</u> # Then Jerubbaal, who [is] Gideon, and all the people that [were] with him, rose up early, and pitched beside the well of Harod: so that the host of the Midianites were on the north side of them, by the hill of Moreh, in the valley.

Harodite Elika the 10\_2SA\_23\_25 # Shammah the Harodite, Elika the Harodite,

Harodite 10\_2SA\_23\_25 # Shammah the Harodite, Elika the Harodite,

Herod and from <u>44\_ACT\_12\_11</u># And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a surety, that the Lord hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and [from] all the expectation of the people of the Jews.

Herod and Pontius <u>44\_ACT\_04\_27</u># For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,

Herod and them <u>41\_MAR\_06\_22</u> # And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in, and danced, and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou wilt, and I will give [it] thee.

Herod arrayed in 44\_ACT\_12\_21 # And upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his throne, and made an oration unto them.

Herod being tetrarch <u>42\_LUK\_03\_01</u># Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Herod feared John <u>41 MAR 06 20 #</u> For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly.

Herod for I <u>42\_LUK\_23\_15</u> # No, nor yet Herod: for I sent you to him; and, lo, nothing worthy of death is done unto him.

Herod had done <u>42\_LUK\_03\_19</u># But Herod the tetrarch, being reproved by him for Herodias his brother Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done,

Herod had laid <u>40\_MAT\_14\_03</u># For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put [him] in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

Herod on his <u>41\_MAR\_06\_21</u> # And when a convenient day was come, that Herod on his birthday made a supper to his lords, high captains, and chief [estates] of Galilee;

Herod said John <u>42\_LUK\_09\_09</u> # And Herod said, John have I beheaded: but who is this, of whom I hear such things? And he desired to see him.

Herod the king <u>44\_ACT\_12\_01</u> # Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth [his] hands to vex certain of the church.

Herod the king <u>42 LUK\_01\_05</u> # There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife [was] of the daughters of Aaron, and her name [was] Elisabeth.

Herod will kill <u>42\_LUK\_13\_31</u> # The same day there came certain of the Pharisees, saying unto him, Get thee out, and depart hence: for Herod will kill thee.

Herod will seek <u>40\_MAT\_02\_13</u># And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

Herod with his <u>42\_LUK\_23\_11</u># And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked [him], and arrayed him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.

Herod would have 44\_ACT\_12\_06 # And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison.

Herod <u>41\_MAR\_08\_15</u># And he charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and [of] the leaven of Herod.

Herod <u>40\_MAT\_14\_06</u># But when Herod's birthday was kept, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod.

Merodach is broken <u>24\_JER\_50\_02</u> # Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, [and] conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.

Merodachbaladan the son <u>23\_ISA\_39\_01</u># At that time Merodachbaladan, the son of Baladan, king of Babylon, sent letters and a present to Hezekiah: for he had heard that he had been sick, and was recovered.

Nimrod he began 13\_1CH\_01\_10 # And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be mighty upon the earth.

Nimrod he began 01\_GEN\_10\_08 # And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.

Nimrod in the <u>33\_MIC\_05\_06</u># And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver [us] from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.

Nimrod the mighty <u>01\_GEN\_10\_09</u> # He was a mighty hunter before the LORD: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD.
