ropes and bound <u>07\_JUD\_16\_12</u># Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And [there were] liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread.

ropes of the <u>44\_ACT\_27\_32</u> # Then the soldiers cut off the ropes of the boat, and let her fall off.

ropes on their <u>11\_1KI\_20\_32</u># So they girded sackcloth on their loins, and [put] ropes on their heads, and came to the king of Israel, and said, Thy servant Benhadad saith, I pray thee, let me live. And he said, [Is] he yet alive? he [is] my brother.

ropes that never <u>07\_JUD\_16\_11</u># And he said unto her, If they bind me fast with new ropes that never were occupied, then shall I be weak, and be as another man.

ropes to that <u>10\_2SA\_17\_13</u> # Moreover, if he be gotten into a city, then shall all Israel bring ropes to that city, and we will draw it into the river, until there be not one small stone found there.

ropes upon our <u>11\_1KI\_20\_31</u># And his servants said unto him, Behold now, we have heard that the kings of the house of Israel [are] merciful kings: let us, I pray thee, put sackcloth on our loins, and ropes upon our heads, and go out to the king of Israel: peradventure he will save thy life.
