Ashtaroth and at [06 JOS 12 04](#) # And the coast of Og king of Bashan, [which was] of the remnant of the giants, that dwelt at Ashtaroth and at Edrei,

Ashtaroth and Edrei [06 JOS 13 31](#) # And half Gilead, and Ashtaroth, and Edrei, cities of the kingdom of Og in Bashan, [were pertaining] unto the children of Machir the son of Manasseh, [even] to the one half of the children of Machir by their families.

Ashtaroth and in [06 JOS 13 12](#) # All the kingdom of Og in Bashan, which reigned in Ashtaroth and in Edrei, who remained of the remnant of the giants: for these did Moses smite, and cast them out.

Ataroth and Dibon [04 NUM 32 03](#) # Ataroth, and Dibon, and Jazer, and Nimrah, and Heshbon, and Elealeh, and Shebam, and Nebo, and Beon,

Ataroth and to [06 JOS 16 07](#) # And it went down from Janohah to Ataroth, and to Naarath, and came to Jericho, and went out at Jordan.

Ataroth the house [13 1CH 02 54](#) # The sons of Salma; Bethlehem, and the Netophathites, Ataroth, the house of Joab, and half of the Manahethites, the Zorites.

Ataroth [06 JOS 16 02](#) # And goeth out from Bethel to Luz, and passeth along unto the borders of Archi to Ataroth,

Berothite the armourbearer [13 1CH 11 39](#) # Zelek the Ammonite, Naharai the Berothite, the armourbearer of Joab the son of Zeruah,

betroth a wife [05 DEU 28 30](#) # Thou shalt betroth a wife, and another man shall lie with her: thou shalt build an house, and thou shalt not dwell therein: thou shalt plant a vineyard, and shalt not gather the grapes thereof.

betroth thee unto [28 HOS 02 19](#) # And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

betroth thee unto [28 HOS 02 19](#) # And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

betrothed and lay [05 DEU 22 28](#) # If a man find a damsel [that is] a virgin, which is not betrothed, and lay hold on her, and lie with her, and they be found;

betrothed and lie [02 EXO 22 16](#) # And if a man entice a maid that is not betrothed, and lie with her, he shall surely endow her to be his wife.

betrothed damsel cried [05 DEU 22 27](#) # For he found her in the field, [and] the betrothed damsel cried, and [there was] none to save her.

betrothed damsel in [05 DEU 22 25](#) # But if a man find a betrothed damsel in the field, and the man force her, and lie with her: then the man only that lay with her shall die:

betrothed her to [02 EXO 21 08](#) # If she please not her master, who hath betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt deceitfully with her.

betrothed her unto [02 EXO 21 09](#) # And if he have betrothed her unto his son, he shall deal with her after the manner of daughters.

betrothed to an [03 LEV 19 20](#) # And whosoever lieth carnally with a woman, that [is] a bondmaid, betrothed to an husband, and not at all redeemed, nor freedom given her; she shall be scourged; they shall not be put to death, because she was not free.

betrothed unto an [05 DEU 22 23](#) # If a damsel [that is] a virgin be betrothed unto an husband, and a man find her in the city, and lie with her;

broth And he [07 JUD 06 20](#) # And the angel of God said unto him, Take the flesh and the unleavened cakes, and lay [them] upon this rock, and pour out the broth. And he did so.

broth in a [07\\_JUD\\_06\\_19](#) # And Gideon went in, and made ready a kid, and unleavened cakes of an ephah of flour: the flesh he put in a basket, and he put the broth in a pot, and brought [it] out unto him under the oak, and presented [it].

brother abideth in [62\\_1JO\\_02\\_10](#) # He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.

brother abideth in [62\\_1JO\\_03\\_14](#) # We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not [his] brother abideth in death.

brother Absalom's house [10\\_2SA\\_13\\_20](#) # And Absalom her brother said unto her, Hath Amnon thy brother been with thee? but hold now thy peace, my sister: he [is] thy brother; regard not this thing. So Tamar remained desolate in her brother Absalom's house.

brother and carried [14 2CH 36 04](#) # And the king of Egypt made Eliakim his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem, and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother, and carried him to Egypt.

brother and companion [50 PHP 02 25](#) # Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants.

brother and companion [66 REV 01 09](#) # I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

brother and Kemuel [01\\_GEN\\_22\\_21](#) # Huz his firstborn, and Buz his brother, and Kemuel the father of Aram,

brother and minister [52\\_1TH\\_03\\_02](#) # And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlabourer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith:

brother and my [41\\_MAR\\_03\\_35](#) # For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.

brother and our [01\\_GEN\\_37\\_27](#) # Come, and let us sell him to the Ishmeelites, and let not our hand be upon him; for he [is] our brother [and] our flesh. And his brethren were content.

brother and said [07\\_JUD\\_21\\_06](#) # And the children of Israel repented them for Benjamin their brother, and said, There is one tribe cut off from Israel this day.

brother and sister [40\\_MAT\\_12\\_50](#) # For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the

brother any thing [05 DEU 24 10](#) # When thou dost lend thy brother any thing, thou shalt not go into his house to fetch his pledge.

brother Apollos I [46 1CO 16 12](#) # As touching [our] brother Apollos, I greatly desired him to come unto you with the brethren: but his will was not at all to come at this time; but he will come when he shall have convenient time.

brother Asahel at [10 2SA 03 30](#) # So Joab and Abishai his brother slew Abner, because he had slain their brother Asahel at Gibeon in the battle.

brother Asaph who [13 1CH 06 39](#) # And his brother Asaph, who stood on his right hand, [even] Asaph the son of Berachiah, the son of Shimea,

brother at the [14 2CH 31 13](#) # And Jehiel, and Azaziah, and Nahath, and Asahel, and Jerimoth, and Jozabad, and Eliel, and Ismachiah, and Mahath, and Benaiah, [were] overseers under the hand of Cononiah and Shimei his brother, at the commandment of Hezekiah the king, and Azariah the ruler of the house of God.

brother be a [46 1CO 05 11](#) # But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.

brother be grieved [45 ROM 14 15](#) # But if thy brother be grieved with [thy] meat, now walkest thou not charitably. Destroy not him with thy meat, for whom Christ died.

brother be not [05 DEU 22 02](#) # And if thy brother [be] not nigh unto thee, or if thou know him not, then thou shalt bring it unto thine own house, and it shall be with thee until thy brother seek after it, and thou shalt restore it to him again.

brother Be of [23 ISA 41 06](#) # They helped every one his neighbour; and [every one] said to his brother, Be of good courage.

wrote Rehum the [15 EZR 04 09](#) # Then [wrote] Rehum the chancellor, and Shimshai the scribe, and the rest of their companions; the Dinaites, the Apharsathchites, the Tarpelites, the Apharsites, the Archevites, the Babylonians, the Susanchites, the Dehavites, [and] the Elamites,

wrote saying His [42 LUK 01 63](#) # And he asked for a writing table, and wrote, saying, His name is John. And they marvelled all.

wrote the dream [27 DAN 07 01](#) # In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon Daniel had a dream and visions of his head upon his bed: then he wrote the dream, [and] told the sum of the matters.

wrote their goings [04 NUM 33 02](#) # And Moses wrote their goings out according to their journeys by the commandment of the LORD: and these [are] their journeys according to their goings out.

wrote them before [13 1CH 24 06](#) # And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.

wrote them in [05 DEU 05 22](#) # These words the LORD spake unto all your assembly in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, with a great voice: and he added no more. And he wrote them in two tables of stone, and delivered them unto me.

wrote them upon [05 DEU 04 13](#) # And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, [even] ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.

wrote them with [24 JER 36 18](#) # Then Baruch answered them, He pronounced all these words unto me with his mouth, and I wrote [them] with ink in the book.

wrote there upon [06 JOS 08 32](#) # And he wrote there upon the stones a copy of the law of Moses, which he wrote in the presence of the children of Israel.

wrote therein from [24 JER 36 32](#) # Then took Jeremiah another roll, and gave it to Baruch the scribe, the son of Neriah; who wrote therein from the mouth of Jeremiah all the words of the book which Jehoiakim king of Judah had burned in the fire: and there were added besides unto them many like words.

wrote these things [17 EST 09 20](#) # And Mordecai wrote these things, and sent letters unto all the Jews that [were] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, [both] nigh and far,

wrote these things [43 JOH 21 24](#) # This is the disciple which testifieth of these things, and wrote these things: and we know that his testimony is true.

wrote these words [06 JOS 24 26](#) # And Joshua wrote these words in the book of the law of God, and took a great stone, and set it up there under an oak, that [was] by the sanctuary of the LORD.

wrote they unto [15 EZR 04 06](#) # And in the reign of Ahasuerus, in the beginning of his reign, wrote they [unto him] an accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.

wrote this epistle [45 ROM 16 22](#) # I Tertius, who wrote [this] epistle, salute you in the Lord.

wrote this law [05 DEU 31 09](#) # And Moses wrote this law, and delivered it unto the priests the sons of Levi, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and unto all the elders of Israel.

wrote this same [47 2CO 02 03](#) # And I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to rejoice; having confidence in you all, that my joy is [the joy] of you all.

wrote this song [05 DEU 31 22](#) # Moses therefore wrote this song the same day, and taught it the children of Israel.

wrote to destroy [17 EST 08 05](#) # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

wrote unto all [27 DAN 06 25](#) # Then king Darius wrote unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you.

wrote unto me [46 1CO 07 01](#) # Now concerning the things whereof ye wrote unto me: [It is] good for a man not to touch a woman.

wrote unto the [64 3JO 01 09](#) # I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

wrote unto thee [57 PHM 01 21](#) # Having confidence in thy obedience I wrote unto thee, knowing that thou wilt also do more than I say.

wrote unto us [42 LUK 20 28](#) # Saying, Master, Moses wrote unto us, If any man's brother die, having a wife, and he die without children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

wrote unto us [41 MAR 12 19](#) # Master, Moses wrote unto us, If a man's brother die, and leave [his] wife [behind him], and leave no children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

wrote unto you [46 1CO 05 09](#) # I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators:

wrote unto you [47 2CO 02 04](#) # For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote unto you with many tears; not that ye should be grieved, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you.

wrote unto you [47 2CO 07 12](#) # Wherefore, though I wrote unto you, [I did it] not for his cause that had done the wrong, nor for his cause that suffered wrong, but that our care for you in the sight of God might appear unto you.

wrote upon it [02 EXO 39 30](#) # And they made the plate of the holy crown [of] pure gold, and wrote upon it a writing, [like to] the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

wrote upon the [02 EXO 34 28](#) # And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

wrote [27 DAN 05 05](#) # In the same hour came forth fingers of a man's hand, and wrote over against the

candlestick upon the plaster of the wall of the king's palace: and the king saw the part of the hand that wrote.

wroth against two [01\\_GEN\\_40\\_02](#) # And Pharaoh was wroth against two [of] his officers, against the chief of the butlers, and against the chief of the bakers.

wroth against us [25\\_LAM\\_05\\_22](#) # But thou hast utterly rejected us; thou art very wroth against us.

wroth against you [05\\_DEU\\_09\\_19](#) # For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD was wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also.
