

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

reared up altars 14_2CH_33_03 # For he built again the high places which Hezekiah his father had broken down, and he reared up altars for Baalim, and made groves, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served them.

reared up altars 12 2KI 21 03 # For he built up again the high places which Hezekiah his father had destroyed; and he reared up altars for Baal, and made a grove, as did Ahab king of Israel; and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served them.

reared up an <u>11_1KI_16_32</u># And he reared up an altar for Baal in the house of Baal, which he had built in Samaria.

reared up for 10_2SA_18_18_# Now Absalom in his lifetime had taken and reared up for himself a pillar, which [is] in the king's dale: for he said, I have no son to keep my name in remembrance: and he called the pillar after his own name: and it is called unto this day, Absalom's place.

reared up his <u>02_EXO_40_18</u># And Moses reared up the tabernacle, and fastened his sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up his pillars.

reared up the <u>14_2CH_03_17</u># And he reared up the pillars before the temple, one on the right hand, and the other on the left; and called the name of that on the right hand Jachin, and the name of that on the left Boaz.

reared up the <u>02_EXO_40_18</u> # And Moses reared up the tabernacle, and fastened his sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up his pillars.

reared up the <u>02_EXO_40_33</u> # And he reared up the court round about the tabernacle and the altar, and set up the hanging of the court gate. So Moses finished the work.

reared up the <u>04_NUM_09_15</u># And on the day that the tabernacle was reared up the cloud covered the tabernacle, [namely], the tent of the testimony: and at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning.

reared up <u>02_EXO_40_17</u> # And it came to pass in the first month in the second year, on the first [day] of the month, [that] the tabernacle was reared up.
