rend all their [26\\_EZE\\_29\\_07](#) # When they took hold of thee by thy hand, thou didst break, and rend all their shoulder: and when they leaned upon thee, thou brakest, and madest all their loins to be at a stand.

rend and a [21\\_ECC\\_03\\_07](#) # A time to rend, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;

rend away all [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_13](#) # Howbeit I will not rend away all the kingdom; [but] will give one tribe to thy son for David my servant's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have chosen.

rend his clothes [03\\_LEV\\_21\\_10](#) # And [he that is] the high priest among his brethren, upon whose head the anointing oil was poured, and that is consecrated to put on the garments, shall not uncover his head, nor rend his clothes;

rend it but [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_24](#) # They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did.

rend it out [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_12](#) # Notwithstanding in thy days I will not do it for David thy father's sake: [but] I will rend it out of the hand of thy son.

rend it out [03\\_LEV\\_13\\_56](#) # And if the priest look, and, behold, the plague [be] somewhat dark after the washing of it; then he shall rend it out of the garment, or out of the skin, or out of the warp, or out of the woof:

rend it with [26\\_EZE\\_13\\_13](#) # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; I will even rend [it] with a stormy wind in my fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower in mine anger, and great hailstones in [my] fury to consume [it].

rend it [26\\_EZE\\_13\\_11](#) # Say unto them which daub [it] with untempered [mortar], that it shall fall: there shall be an overflowing shower; and ye, O great hailstones, shall fall; and a stormy wind shall rend [it].

rend the caul [28\\_HOS\\_13\\_08](#) # I will meet them as a bear [that is] bereaved [of her whelps], and will rend the caul of their heart, and there will I devour them like a lion: the wild beast shall tear them.

rend the heavens [23\\_ISA\\_64\\_01](#) # Oh that thou wouldest rend the heavens, that thou wouldest come down, that the mountains might flow down at thy presence.

rend the kingdom [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_11](#) # Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant.

rend the kingdom [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_31](#) # And he said to Jeroboam, Take thee ten pieces: for thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, Behold, I will rend the kingdom out of the hand of Solomon, and will give ten tribes to thee:

rend thy clothes [14\\_2CH\\_34\\_27](#) # Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard [thee] also, saith the LORD.

rend you [40\\_MAT\\_07\\_06](#) # Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.

Rend your clothes [10\\_2SA\\_03\\_31](#) # And David said to Joab, and to all the people that [were] with him, Rend your clothes, and gird you with sackcloth, and mourn before Abner. And king David [himself] followed the bier.

rend your clothes [03\\_LEV\\_10\\_06](#) # And Moses said unto Aaron, and unto Eleazar and unto Ithamar, his sons, Uncover not your heads, neither rend your clothes; lest ye die, and lest wrath come upon all the people: but let your brethren, the whole house of Israel, bewail the burning which the LORD hath kindled.

rend your heart [29\\_JOE\\_02\\_13](#) # And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he [is] gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil.

rend [02\\_EXO\\_39\\_23](#) # And [there was] an hole in the midst of the robe, as the hole of an habergeon, [with] a band round about the hole, that it should not rend.

render a reason [20\\_PRO\\_26\\_16](#) # The sluggard [is] wiser in his own conceit than seven men that can render a reason.

render a reward [19\\_PSA\\_94\\_02](#) # Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the proud.

render double unto [38\\_ZEC\\_09\\_12](#) # Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of hope: even to day do I declare [that] I will render double unto thee;

render evil for [52\\_1TH\\_05\\_15](#) # See that none render evil for evil unto any [man]; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all [men].

render evil for [19\\_PSA\\_38\\_20](#) # They also that render evil for good are mine adversaries; because I follow [the thing that] good [is].

render him the [40\\_MAT\\_21\\_41](#) # They say unto him, He will miserably destroy those wicked men, and will let out [his] vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons.

render his anger [23\\_ISA\\_66\\_15](#) # For, behold, the LORD will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire.

render me a [29\\_JOE\\_03\\_04](#) # Yea, and what have ye to do with me, O Tyre, and Zidon, and all the coasts of Palestine? will ye render me a recompense? and if ye recompense me, swiftly [and] speedily will I return your recompense upon your own head;

render praises unto [19\\_PSA\\_56\\_12](#) # Thy vows [are] upon me, O God: I will render praises unto thee.

render the calves [28\\_HOS\\_14\\_02](#) # Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive [us] graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips.

Render therefore to [45\\_ROM\\_13\\_07](#) # Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute [is due]; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

Render therefore unto [42\\_LUK\\_20\\_25](#) # And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.

Render therefore unto [40\\_MAT\\_22\\_21](#) # They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render

therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.

Render to Caesar [41 MAR 12 17](#) # And Jesus answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. And they marvelled at him.

render to every [09 ISA 26 23](#) # The LORD render to every man his righteousness and his faithfulness: for the LORD delivered thee into [my] hand to day, but I would not stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed.

render to every [20 PRO 24 12](#) # If thou sayest, Behold, we knew it not; doth not he that pondereth the heart consider [it]? and he that keepeth thy soul, doth [not] he know [it]? and shall [not] he render to [every] man according to his works?

render to every [45 ROM 02 06](#) # Who will render to every man according to his deeds:

render to God [52 1TH 03 09](#) # For what thanks can we render to God again for you, for all the joy wherewith we joy for your sakes before our God;

render to the [20 PRO 24 29](#) # Say not, I will do so to him as he hath done to me: I will render to the man according to his work.

render to them [19 PSA 28 04](#) # Give them according to their deeds, and according to the wickedness of their endeavours: give them after the work of their hands; render to them their desert.

render unto Babylon [24 JER 51 24](#) # And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in Zion in your sight, saith the LORD.

render unto every [14 2CH 06 30](#) # Then hear thou from heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart thou knowest; [for thou only knowest the hearts of the children of men:]

render unto her [24 JER 51 06](#) # Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this [is] the time of the LORD'S vengeance; he will render unto her a recompense.

render unto him [18 JOB 34 11](#) # For the work of a man shall he render unto him, and cause every man to find according to [his] ways.

render unto man [18 JOB 33 26](#) # He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness.

render unto me [04 NUM 18 09](#) # This shall be thine of the most holy things, [reserved] from the fire: every oblation of theirs, every meat offering of theirs, and every sin offering of theirs, and every trespass offering of theirs, which they shall render unto me, [shall be] most holy for thee and for thy sons.

render unto our [19 PSA 79 12](#) # And render unto our neighbours sevenfold into their bosom their reproach, wherewith they have reproached thee, O Lord.

render unto the [46 1CO 07 03](#) # Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband.

render unto the [19 PSA 116 12](#) # What shall I render unto the LORD [for] all his benefits toward me?

Render unto them [25 LAM 03 64](#) # Render unto them a recompense, O LORD, according to the work of their hands.

render upon their [07\\_JUD\\_09\\_57](#) # And all the evil of the men of Shechem did God render upon their heads: and upon them came the curse of Jotham the son of Jerubbaal.

render vengeance to [05\\_DEU\\_32\\_41](#) # If I whet my glittering sword, and mine hand take hold on judgment; I will render vengeance to mine enemies, and will reward them that hate me.

render vengeance to [05\\_DEU\\_32\\_43](#) # Rejoice, O ye nations, [with] his people: for he will avenge the blood of his servants, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful unto his land, [and] to his people.

rendered not again [14\\_2CH\\_32\\_25](#) # But Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit [done] unto him; for his heart was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem.

rendered the wickedness [07\\_JUD\\_09\\_56](#) # Thus God rendered the wickedness of Abimelech, which he did unto his father, in slaying his seventy brethren:

rendered unto him [20\\_PRO\\_12\\_14](#) # A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of [his] mouth: and the recompense of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.

rendered unto the [12\\_2KI\\_03\\_04](#) # And Mesha king of Moab was a sheepmaster, and rendered unto the king of Israel an hundred thousand lambs, and an hundred thousand rams, with the wool.

renderest to every [19\\_PSA\\_62\\_12](#) # Also unto thee, O Lord, [belongeth] mercy: for thou renderest to every man according to his work.

rendereth recompense to [23\\_ISA\\_66\\_06](#) # A voice of noise from the city, a voice from the temple, a voice of the LORD that rendereth recompense to his enemies.

rendering evil for [60\\_1PE\\_03\\_09](#) # Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.

rending it in [19\\_PSA\\_07\\_02](#) # Lest he tear my soul like a lion, rending [it] in pieces, while [there is] none to deliver.

reverend is his [19\\_PSA\\_111\\_09](#) # He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant for ever: holy and reverend [is] his name.
