rotten rags and [24 JER 38 11](#) # So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

rotten rags under [24 JER 38 12](#) # And Ebedmelech the Ethiopian said unto Jeremiah, Put now [these] old cast clouts and rotten rags under thine armholes under the cords. And Jeremiah did so.

rotten thing consumeth [18 JOB 13 28](#) # And he, as a rotten thing, consumeth, as a garment that is moth eaten.

rotten under their [29 JOE 01 17](#) # The seed is rotten under their clods, the garners are laid desolate, the barns are broken down; for the corn is withered.

rotten wood [18 JOB 41 27](#) # He esteemeth iron as straw, [and] brass as rotten wood.

rotteness and their [23 ISA 05 24](#) # Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, [so] their root shall be as rotteness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

rotteness [28 HOS 05 12](#) # Therefore [will] I [be] unto Ephraim as a moth, and to the house of Judah as rotteness.
