Asia when they 44\_ACT\_21\_27 # And when the seven days were almost ended, the Jews which were of Asia, when they saw him in the temple, stirred up all the people, and laid hands on him,

Jesiah the second 13\_1CH\_23\_20 # Of the sons of Uzziel; Micah the first, and Jesiah the second.

Josiah and all <u>14\_2CH\_35\_25</u># And Jeremiah lamented for Josiah: and all the singing men and the singing women spake of Josiah in their lamentations to this day, and made them an ordinance in Israel: and, behold, they [are] written in the lamentations.

Josiah and all 12 2KI 23 28 # Now the rest of the acts of Josiah, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Josiah and anointed 12 2KI 23 30 # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

Persia 14\_2CH\_36\_20 # And them that had escaped from the sword carried he away to Babylon; where they were servants to him and his sons until the reign of the kingdom of Persia:

Persia <u>27\_DAN\_08\_20</u># The ram which thou sawest having [two] horns [are] the kings of Media and Persia.

Persia <u>27\_DAN\_10\_13</u># But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia.

Persia <u>17\_EST\_10\_02</u> # And all the acts of his power and of his might, and the declaration of the greatness of Mordecai, whereunto the king advanced him, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Media and Persia?

Persia <u>15\_EZR\_03\_07</u> # They gave money also unto the masons, and to the carpenters; and meat, and drink, and oil, unto them of Zidon, and to them of Tyre, to bring cedar trees from Lebanon to the sea of Joppa, according to the grant that they had of Cyrus king of Persia.

Persia <u>15\_EZR\_04\_05</u> # And hired counsellors against them, to frustrate their purpose, all the days of Cyrus king of Persia, even until the reign of Darius king of Persia.

Persia 15\_EZR\_04\_24 # Then ceased the work of the house of God which [is] at Jerusalem. So it ceased unto the second year of the reign of Darius king of Persia.

Persia 15\_EZR\_06\_14 # And the elders of the Jews builded, and they prospered through the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the son of Iddo. And they builded, and finished [it], according to the commandment of the God of Israel, and according to the commandment of Cyrus, and Darius, and Artaxerxes king of Persia.

Persian <u>27\_DAN\_06\_28</u># So this Daniel prospered in the reign of Darius, and in the reign of Cyrus the Persian.

Persian <u>16\_NEH\_12\_22</u> # The Levites in the days of Eliashib, Joiada, and Johanan, and Jaddua, [were] recorded chief of the fathers: also the priests, to the reign of Darius the Persian.

Persians and the <u>17\_EST\_01\_19</u> # If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

Persians is That <u>27\_DAN\_06\_15</u># Then these men assembled unto the king, and said unto the king, Know, O king, that the law of the Medes and Persians [is], That no decree nor statute which the king establisheth may be changed.

Persians which altereth <u>27\_DAN\_06\_08</u> # Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

Persians which altereth <u>27\_DAN\_06\_12</u># Then they came near, and spake before the king concerning the king's decree; Hast thou not signed a decree, that every man that shall ask [a petition] of any God or man within thirty days, save of thee, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions? The king answered and said, The thing [is] true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

Persians 27\_DAN\_05\_28 # PERES; Thy kingdom is divided, and given to the Medes and Persians.
