Bathsheba And she <u>11\_1KI\_01\_28</u># Then king David answered and said, Call me Bathsheba. And she came into the king's presence, and stood before the king.

Bathsheba bowed and <u>11\_1KI\_01\_16</u># And Bathsheba bowed, and did obeisance unto the king. And the king said, What wouldest thou?

Bathsheba bowed with <u>11\_1KI\_01\_31</u># Then Bathsheba bowed with [her] face to the earth, and did reverence to the king, and said, Let my lord king David live for ever.

Bathsheba Have mercy <u>19\_PSA\_51\_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot outmy transgressions.

Bathsheba his wife <u>10\_2SA\_12\_24</u> # And David comforted Bathsheba his wife, and went in unto her, and lay with her: and she bare a son, and he called his name Solomon: and the LORD loved him.

Bathsheba said Well <u>11\_1KI\_02\_18</u># And Bathsheba said, Well; I will speak for thee unto the king.

Bathsheba the daughter <u>10\_2SA\_11\_03</u> # And David sent and inquired after the woman. And [one] said, [Is] not this Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?

Bathsheba the mother <u>11\_1KI\_01\_11</u># Wherefore Nathan spake unto Bathsheba the mother of Solomon, saying, Hast thou not heard that Adonijah the son of Haggith doth reign, and David our lord knoweth [it] not?

Bathsheba the mother <u>11\_1KI\_02\_13</u># And Adonijah the son of Haggith came to Bathsheba the mother of Solomon. And she said, Comest thou peaceably? And he said, Peaceably.

Bathsheba therefore went <u>11\_1KI\_02\_19</u># Bathsheba therefore went unto king Solomon, to speak unto him for Adonijah. And the king rose up to meet her, and bowed himself unto her, and sat down on his throne, and caused a seat to be set for the king's mother; and she sat on his right hand.

Bathsheba went in <u>11\_1KI\_01\_15</u># And Bathsheba went in unto the king into the chamber: and the king was very old; and Abishag the Shunammite ministered unto the king.

Beersheba all the <u>11\_1KI\_04\_25</u># And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, every man under his vine and under his fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon.

Beersheba and Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u> # So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Beersheba and Bizjothjah <u>06\_JOS\_15\_28</u># And Hazarshual, and Beersheba, and Bizjothjah,

Beersheba and brake <u>12\_2KI\_23\_08</u> # And he brought all the priests out of the cities of Judah, and defiled the high places where the priests had burned incense, from Geba to Beersheba, and brake down the high places of the gates that [were] in the entering in of the gate of Joshua the governor of the city, which [were] on a man's left hand at the gate of the city.

Beersheba and called <u>01\_GEN\_21\_33</u># And [Abraham] planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God.

Beersheba and offered <u>01\_GEN\_46\_01</u># And Israel took his journey with all that he had, and came to Beersheba, and offered sacrifices unto the God of his father Isaac.

Beersheba and Sheba <u>06\_JOS\_19\_02</u># And they had in their inheritance Beersheba, and Sheba, and Moladah,

Beersheba and the <u>01\_GEN\_46\_05</u> # And Jacob rose up from Beersheba: and the sons of Israel carried Jacob their father, and their little ones, and their wives, in the wagons which Pharaoh had sent to carry him.

Beersheba and went <u>01\_GEN\_28\_10</u> # And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran.

Beersheba as the <u>10\_2SA\_17\_11</u># Therefore I counsel that all Israel be generally gathered unto thee, from Dan even to Beersheba, as the sand that [is] by the sea for multitude; and that thou go to battle in thine own person.

Beersheba because there <u>01\_GEN\_21\_31</u># Wherefore he called that place Beersheba; because there they sware both of them.

Beersheba even to <u>13\_1CH\_21\_02</u> # And David said to Joab and to the rulers of the people, Go, number Israel from Beersheba even to Dan; and bring the number of them to me, that I may know [it].

Beersheba even to <u>14\_2CH\_30\_05</u># So they established a decree to make proclamation throughout all Israel, from Beersheba even to Dan, that they should come to keep the passover unto the LORD God of Israel at Jerusalem: for they had not done [it] of a long [time in such sort] as it was written.

Beersheba for Gilgal <u>30\_AMO\_05\_05</u> # But seek not Bethel, nor enter into Gilgal, and pass not to Beersheba: for Gilgal shall surely go into captivity, and Bethel shall come to nought.

Beersheba knew that <u>09\_1SA\_03\_20</u> # And all Israel from Dan even to Beersheba knew that Samuel [was] established [to be] a prophet of the LORD.

Beersheba liveth even <u>30\_AMO\_08\_14</u># They that swear by the sin of Samaria, and say, Thy god, O Dan, liveth; and, The manner of Beersheba liveth; even they shall fall, and never rise up again.

Beersheba seventy thousand <u>10\_2SA\_24\_15</u> # So the LORD sent a pestilence upon Israel from the morning even to the time appointed: and there died of the people from Dan even to Beersheba seventy thousand men.

Beersheba then Abimelech <u>01\_GEN\_21\_32</u> # Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines.

Beersheba to mount <u>14\_2CH\_19\_04</u># And Jehoshaphat dwelt at Jerusalem: and he went out again through the people from Beersheba to mount Ephraim, and brought them back unto the LORD God of their

fathers.

Beersheba unto the <u>16\_NEH\_11\_30</u># Zanoah, Adullam, and [in] their villages, at Lachish, and the fields thereof, at Azekah, and [in] the villages thereof. And they dwelt from Beersheba unto the valley of Hinnom.

Beersheba unto this <u>01\_GEN\_26\_33</u> # And he called it Shebah: therefore the name of the city [is] Beersheba unto this day.

Beersheba which belongeth <u>11\_1KI\_19\_03</u># And when he saw [that], he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which [belongeth] to Judah, and left his servant there.

Beersheba with the <u>07\_JUD\_20\_01</u># Then all the children of Israel went out, and the congregation was gathered together as one man, from Dan even to Beersheba, with the land of Gilead, unto the LORD in Mizpeh.

Beersheba <u>09\_1SA\_08\_02</u> # Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah: [they were] judges in Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>14\_2CH\_24\_01</u> # Joash [was] seven years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>12\_2KI\_12\_01</u> # In the seventh year of Jehu Jehoash began to reign; and forty years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>10\_2SA\_03\_10</u># To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>10\_2SA\_24\_07</u> # And came to the strong hold of Tyre, and to all the cities of the Hivites, and of the Canaanites: and they went out to the south of Judah, [even] to Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>01\_GEN\_21\_14</u># And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave [it] unto Hagar, putting [it] on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Elisheba daughter of <u>02\_EXO\_06\_23</u># And Aaron took him Elisheba, daughter of Amminadab, sister of Naashon, to wife; and she bare him Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.

Jehosheba the daughter <u>12\_2KI\_11\_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Sheba all her <u>11\_1KI\_10\_13</u># And king Solomon gave unto the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside [that] which Solomon gave her of his royal bounty. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants.

Sheba all her <u>14\_2CH\_09\_12</u># And king Solomon gave to the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside [that] which she had brought unto the king. So she turned, and went away to her own land, she and her servants.

Sheba and Dedan 13\_1CH\_01\_09 # And the sons of Cush; Seba, and Havilah, and Sabta, and Raamah, and

Sabtecha. And the sons of Raamah; Sheba, and Dedan.

Sheba and Dedan <u>13\_1CH\_01\_32</u> # Now the sons of Keturah, Abraham's concubine: she bare Zimran, and Jokshan, and Medan, and Midian, and Ishbak, and Shuah. And the sons of Jokshan; Sheba, and Dedan.

Sheba and Dedan <u>26\_EZE\_38\_13</u> # Sheba, and Dedan, and the merchants of Tarshish, with all the young lions thereof, shall say unto thee, Art thou come to take a spoil? hast thou gathered thy company to take a prey? to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

Sheba and Dedan <u>01\_GEN\_10\_07</u># And the sons of Cush; Seba, and Havilah, and Sabtah, and Raamah, and Sabtechah: and the sons of Raamah; Sheba, and Dedan.

Sheba and Dedan <u>01\_GEN\_25\_03</u># And Jokshan begat Sheba, and Dedan. And the sons of Dedan were Asshurim, and Letushim, and Leummim.

Sheba and Jorai <u>13\_1CH\_05\_13</u># And their brethren of the house of their fathers [were], Michael, and Meshullam, and Sheba, and Jorai, and Jachan, and Zia, and Heber, seven.

Sheba and Moladah <u>06\_JOS\_19\_02</u> # And they had in their inheritance Beersheba, and Sheba, and Moladah,

Sheba and Raamah <u>26\_EZE\_27\_22</u># The merchants of Sheba and Raamah, they [were] thy merchants: they occupied in thy fairs with chief of all spices, and with all precious stones, and gold.

Sheba and Seba <u>19\_PSA\_72\_10</u># The kings of Tarshish and of the isles shall bring presents: the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts.

Sheba and the <u>24\_JER\_06\_20</u> # To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country? your burnt offerings [are] not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.

Sheba Asshur and <u>26\_EZE\_27\_23</u># Haran, and Canneh, and Eden, the merchants of Sheba, Asshur, [and] Chilmad, [were] thy merchants.

Sheba gave king <u>14\_2CH\_09\_09</u> # And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices great abundance, and precious stones: neither was there any such spice as the queen of Sheba gave king Solomon.

Sheba gave to <u>11\_1KI\_10\_10</u># And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices very great store, and precious stones: there came no more such abundance of spices as these which the queen of Sheba gave to king Solomon.

Sheba had seen <u>11\_1KI\_10\_04</u># And when the queen of Sheba had seen all Solomon's wisdom, and the house that he had built,

Sheba had seen <u>14\_2CH\_09\_03</u># And when the queen of Sheba had seen the wisdom of Solomon, and the house that he had built,

Sheba heard of <u>11\_1KI\_10\_01</u># And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions.

Sheba heard of <u>14\_2CH\_09\_01</u> # And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon, she came to prove Solomon with hard questions at Jerusalem, with a very great company, and camels that bare spices, and gold in abundance, and precious stones: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart.

Sheba prayer also <u>19\_PSA\_72\_15</u># And he shall live, and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba: prayer also shall be made for him continually; [and] daily shall he be praised.

Sheba shall come <u>23\_ISA\_60\_06</u># The multitude of camels shall cover thee, the dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; all they from Sheba shall come: they shall bring gold and incense; and they shall show forth the praises of the LORD.

Sheba the son <u>10\_2SA\_20\_01</u> # And there happened to be there a man of Belial, whose name [was] Sheba, the son of Bichri, a Benjamite: and he blew a trumpet, and said, We have no part in David, neither have we inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to his tents, O Israel.

Shebaniah and Pethahiah <u>16\_NEH\_09\_05</u># Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, [and] Pethahiah, said, Stand up [and] bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise.

Shebaniah Bunni Sherebiah <u>16 NEH\_09\_04</u> # Then stood up upon the stairs, of the Levites, Jeshua, and Bani, Kadmiel, Shebaniah, Bunni, Sherebiah, Bani, [and] Chenani, and cried with a loud voice unto the LORD their God.

Shebaniah Hodijah Kelita <u>16\_NEH\_10\_10</u># And their brethren, Shebaniah, Hodijah, Kelita, Pelaiah, Hanan,

Shebaniah Joseph <u>16\_NEH\_12\_14</u> # Of Melicu, Jonathan; of Shebaniah, Joseph;

Shebaniah Malluch <u>16\_NEH\_10\_04</u> # Hattush, Shebaniah, Malluch,

Shebaniah <u>16\_NEH\_10\_12</u># Zaccur, Sherebiah, Shebaniah,
