Assyria and all [23 ISA 08 07](#) # Now therefore, behold, the Lord bringeth up upon them the waters of the river, strong and many, [even] the king of Assyria, and all his glory: and he shall come up over all his channels, and go over all his banks:

Assyria [23 ISA 37 21](#) # Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent unto Hezekiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Whereas thou hast prayed to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria:

Assyria [24 JER 02 36](#) # Why gaddest thou about so much to change thy way? thou also shalt be ashamed of Egypt, as thou wast ashamed of Assyria.

Assyria [24 JER 50 18](#) # Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.

Assyrian and sent [28 HOS 05 13](#) # When Ephraim saw his sickness, and Judah [saw] his wound, then went Ephraim to the Assyrian, and sent to king Jareb: yet could he not heal you, nor cure you of your wound.

Assyrian be beaten [23 ISA 30 31](#) # For through the voice of the LORD shall the Assyrian be beaten down, [which] smote with a rod.

Assyrian fall with [23 ISA 31 08](#) # Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited.

Assyrian founded it [23 ISA 23 13](#) # Behold the land of the Chaldeans; this people was not, [till] the Assyrian founded it for them that dwell in the wilderness: they set up the towers thereof, they raised up the palaces thereof; [and] he brought it to ruin.

Assyrian he shall [23 ISA 10 24](#) # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD of hosts, O my people that dwellest in Zion, be not afraid of the Assyrian: he shall smite thee with a rod, and shall lift up his staff against thee, after the manner of Egypt.

Assyrian in my [23 ISA 14 25](#) # That I will break the Assyrian in my land, and upon my mountains tread him under foot: then shall his yoke depart from off them, and his burden depart from off their shoulders.

Assyrian oppressed them [23 ISA 52 04](#) # For thus saith the Lord GOD, My people went down aforetime into Egypt to sojourn there; and the Assyrian oppressed them without cause.

Assyrian shall be [28 HOS 11 05](#) # He shall not return into the land of Egypt, but the Assyrian shall be his king, because they refused to return.

Assyrian shall come [23 ISA 19 23](#) # In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.

Assyrian shall come [33 MIC 05 05](#) # And this [man] shall be the peace, when the Assyrian shall come into our land: and when he shall tread in our palaces, then shall we raise against him seven shepherds, and eight principal men.

Assyrian the rod [23 ISA 10 05](#) # O Assyrian, the rod of mine anger, and the staff in their hand is mine indignation.

Assyrian was a [26 EZE 31 03](#) # Behold, the Assyrian [was] a cedar in Lebanon with fair branches, and with a shadowing shroud, and of an high stature; and his top was among the thick boughs.

Assyrian when he [33 MIC 05 06](#) # And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver [us] from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.

Assyrians a hundred [23 ISA 37 36](#) # Then the angel of the LORD went forth, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians a hundred and fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they [were] all dead corpses.

Assyrians an hundred [12 2KI 19 35](#) # And it came to pass that night, that the angel of the LORD went out, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians an hundred fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they [were] all dead corpses.

Assyrians and oil [28 HOS 12 01](#) # Ephraim feedeth on wind, and followeth after the east wind: he daily increaseth lies and desolation; and they do make a covenant with the Assyrians, and oil is carried into Egypt.

Assyrians because thou [26 EZE 16 28](#) # Thou hast played the whore also with the Assyrians, because thou wast unsatiable; yea, thou hast played the harlot with them, and yet couldest not be satisfied.

Assyrians her neighbours [26 EZE 23 05](#) # And Aholah played the harlot when she was mine; and she doted on her lovers, on the Assyrians [her] neighbours,

Assyrians her neighbours [26 EZE 23 12](#) # She doted upon the Assyrians [her] neighbours, captains and rulers clothed most gorgeously, horsemen riding upon horses, all of them desirable young men.

Assyrians to be [25 LAM 05 06](#) # We have given the hand [to] the Egyptians, [and to] the Assyrians, to be satisfied with bread.

Assyrians upon whom [26 EZE 23 09](#) # Wherefore I have delivered her into the hand of her lovers, into the hand of the Assyrians, upon whom she doted.

Assyrians with them [26 EZE 23 23](#) # The Babylonians, and all the Chaldeans, Pekod, and Shoa, and Koa, [and] all the Assyrians with them: all of them desirable young men, captains and rulers, great lords and renowned, all of them riding upon horses.

Assyrians [23 ISA 19 23](#) # In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.

Syria And Ahaziah [12 2KI 08 29](#) # And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

Syria and all [26 EZE 16 57](#) # Before thy wickedness was discovered, as at the time of [thy] reproach of the daughters of Syria, and all [that are] round about her, the daughters of the Philistines, which despise thee round about.

Syria and Cilicia [48 GAL 01 21](#) # Afterwards I came into the regions of Syria and Cilicia;

Syria and drave [12 2KI 16 06](#) # At that time Rezin king of Syria recovered Elath to Syria, and drave the Jews from Elath: and the Syrians came to Elath, and dwelt there unto this day.

Syria and he [12 2KI 12 18](#) # And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Syria escaped on [11 1KI 20 20](#) # And they slew every one his man: and the Syrians fled; and Israel pursued them: and Benhadad the king of Syria escaped on an horse with the horsemen.

Syria escaped out [14 2CH 16 07](#) # And at that time Hanani the seer came to Asa king of Judah, and said unto him, Because thou hast relied on the king of Syria, and not relied on the LORD thy God, therefore is the host of the king of Syria escaped out of thine hand.

Syria for thou [12 2KI 13 17](#) # And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened [it]. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. And he said, The arrow of the LORD'S deliverance, and the arrow of deliverance from Syria: for thou shalt smite the Syrians in Aphek, till thou have consumed [them].

Syria gathered all [11 1KI 20 01](#) # And Benhadad the king of Syria gathered all his host together: and [there were] thirty and two kings with him, and horses, and chariots: and he went up and besieged Samaria, and warred against it.

Syria gathered all [12 2KI 06 24](#) # And it came to pass after this, that Benhadad king of Syria gathered all his host, and went up, and besieged Samaria.

Syria had commanded [14 2CH 18 30](#) # Now the king of Syria had commanded the captains of the chariots that [were] with him, saying, Fight ye not with small or great, save only with the king of Israel.

Syria had destroyed [12 2KI 13 07](#) # Neither did he leave of the people to Jehoahaz but fifty horsemen, and ten chariots, and ten thousand footmen; for the king of Syria had destroyed them, and had made them like the dust by threshing.

Syria hath sent [12 2KI 08 09](#) # So Hazael went to meet him, and took a present with him, even of every good thing of Damascus, forty camels' burden, and came and stood before him, and said, Thy son Benhadad king of Syria hath sent me to thee, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

Syria he purposed [44 ACT 20 03](#) # And [there] abode three months. And when the Jews laid wait for him, as he was about to sail into Syria, he purposed to return through Macedonia.

mighty man in valour, [but he was] a leper.

Syria shall go [30 AMO 01 05](#) # I will break also the bar of Damascus, and cut off the inhabitant from the plain of Aven, and him that holdeth the sceptre from the house of Eden: and the people of Syria shall go into captivity unto Kir, saith the LORD.

Syria that dwelt [11 1KI 15 18](#) # Then Asa took all the silver and the gold [that were] left in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and delivered them into the hand of his servants: and king Asa sent them to Benhadad, the son of Tabrimon, the son of Hezion, king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

Syria that dwelt [14 2CH 16 02](#) # Then Asa brought out silver and gold out of the treasures of the house of the LORD and of the king's house, and sent to Benhadad king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

Syria they shall [23 ISA 17 03](#) # The fortress also shall cease from Ephraim, and the kingdom from Damascus, and the remnant of Syria: they shall be as the glory of the children of Israel, saith the LORD of hosts.

Syria till thou [12 2KI 13 19](#) # And the man of God was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have

smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed [it]: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria [but] thrice.

Syria [11 1KI 22 03](#) # And the king of Israel said unto his servants, Know ye that Ramoth in Gilead [is] ours, and we [be] still, [and] take it not out of the hand of the king of Syria?

Syria [12 2KI 08 13](#) # And Hazael said, But what, [is] thy servant a dog, that he should do this great thing? And Elisha answered, The LORD hath showed me that thou [shalt be] king over Syria.

Syria [12 2KI 09 14](#) # So Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi conspired against Joram. [Now Joram had kept Ramothgilead, he and all Israel, because of Hazael king of Syria.

Syria [42 LUK 02 02](#) # [[And] this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.]

Syriack O king [27 DAN 02 04](#) # Then spake the Chaldeans to the king in Syriack, O king, live for ever: tell thy servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation.

Syriadamascus and the [13 1CH 18 06](#) # Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Syriamaachah and out [13 1CH 19 06](#) # And when the children of Ammon saw that they had made themselves odious to David, Hanun and the children of Ammon sent a thousand talents of silver to hire

them chariots and horsemen out of Mesopotamia, and out of Syriamaachah, and out of Zobah.

Syrian in a [01\\_GEN\\_31\\_24](#) # And God came to Laban the Syrian in a dream by night, and said unto him, Take heed that thou speak not to Jacob either good or bad.

Syrian in not [12\\_2KI\\_05\\_20](#) # But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, said, Behold, my master hath spared Naaman this Syrian, in not receiving at his hands that which he brought: but, [as] the LORD liveth, I will run after him, and take somewhat of him.

Syrian language for [23\\_ISA\\_36\\_11](#) # Then said Eliakim and Shebna and Joah unto Rabshakeh, Speak, I pray thee, unto thy servants in the Syrian language; for we understand [it]; and speak not to us in the Jews' language, in the ears of the people that [are] on the wall.

Syrian of Padanaram [01\\_GEN\\_25\\_20](#) # And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padanaram, the sister to Laban the Syrian.

Syrian ready to [05\\_DEU\\_26\\_05](#) # And thou shalt speak and say before the LORD thy God, A Syrian ready to perish [was] my father, and he went down into Egypt, and sojourned there with a few, and became there a nation, great, mighty, and populous:

Syrian the brother [01\\_GEN\\_28\\_05](#) # And Isaac sent away Jacob: and he went to Padanaram unto Laban, son of Bethuel the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother.

Syrians and behold [12\\_2KI\\_07\\_10](#) # So they came and called unto the porter of the city: and they told them, saying, We came to the camp of the Syrians, and, behold, [there was] no man there, neither voice of man, but horses tied, and asses tied, and the tents as they [were].

Syrians and died [11\\_1KI\\_22\\_35](#) # And the battle increased that day: and the king was stayed up in his chariot against the Syrians, and died at even: and the blood ran out of the wound into the midst of the chariot.

Syrians and forty [10\\_2SA\\_10\\_18](#) # And the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew [the men of] seven hundred chariots of the Syrians, and forty thousand horsemen, and smote Shobach the captain of their host, who died there.

Syrians before and [23\\_ISA\\_09\\_12](#) # The Syrians before, and the Philistines behind; and they shall devour Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

Syrians came to [12\\_2KI\\_16\\_06](#) # At that time Rezin king of Syria recovered Elath to Syria, and drave the Jews from Elath: and the Syrians came to Elath, and dwelt there unto this day.

Syrians from Kir [30 AMO 09 07](#) # [Are] ye not as children of the Ethiopians unto me, O children of Israel? saith the LORD. Have not I brought up Israel out of the land of Egypt? and the Philistines from Caphtor, and the Syrians from Kir?

Syrians had cast [12 2KI 07 15](#) # And they went after them unto Jordan: and, lo, all the way [was] full of garments and vessels, which the Syrians had cast away in their haste. And the messengers returned, and told the king.

Syrians had given [12 2KI 08 29](#) # And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

Syrians have said [11 1KI 20 28](#) # And there came a man of God, and spake unto the king of Israel, and said, Thus saith the LORD, Because the Syrians have said, The LORD [is] God of the hills, but he [is] not God of the valleys, therefore will I deliver all this great multitude into thine hand, and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

Syrians help the [13 1CH 19 19](#) # And when the servants of Hadarezer saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they made peace with David, and became his servants: neither would the Syrians help the children of Ammon any more.

Now therefore come, and let us fall unto the host of the Syrians: if they save us alive, we shall live; and if they kill us, we shall but die.

the children of Ammon sent and hired the Syrians of Bethrehob, and the Syrians of Zoba, twenty thousand footmen, and of king Maacah a thousand men, and of Ishtob twelve thousand men.

Syrians of Damascus [13 1CH 18 05](#) # And when the Syrians of Damascus came to help Hadarezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.

Syrians of Damascus [10 2SA 08 05](#) # And when the Syrians of Damascus came to succour Hadadezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.

Syrians of Zoba [10 2SA 10 06](#) # And when the children of Ammon saw that they stank before David, the children of Ammon sent and hired the Syrians of Bethrehob, and the Syrians of Zoba, twenty thousand footmen, and of king Maacah a thousand men, and of Ishtob twelve thousand men.

Syrians of Zoba [10 2SA 10 08](#) # And the children of Ammon came out, and put the battle in array at the entering in of the gate: and the Syrians of Zoba, and of Rehob, and Ishtob, and Maacah, [were] by themselves in the field.

Syrians saw that [13 1CH 19 16](#) # And when the Syrians saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they sent messengers, and drew forth the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and Shophach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.

Syrians saw that [10 2SA 10 15](#) # And when the Syrians saw that they were smitten before Israel, they gathered themselves together.

Syrians saying Go [12 2KI 07 14](#) # They took therefore two chariot horses; and the king sent after the host of the Syrians, saying, Go and see.

Syrians set themselves [10 2SA 10 17](#) # And when it was told David, he gathered all Israel together, and passed over Jordan, and came to Helam. And the Syrians set themselves in array against David, and fought with him.

Syrians seven thousand [13 1CH 19 18](#) # But the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew of the Syrians seven thousand [men which fought in] chariots, and forty thousand footmen, and killed Shophach the captain of the host.

Syrians smote Joram [14 2CH 22 05](#) # He walked also after their counsel, and went with Jehoram the son of Ahab king of Israel to war against Hazael king of Syria at Ramothgilead: and the Syrians smote Joram.

Syrians until the [14 2CH 18 34](#) # And the battle increased that day: howbeit the king of Israel stayed [himself] up in [his] chariot against the Syrians until the even: and about the time of the sun going down he died.

Syrians until thou [11 1KI 22 11](#) # And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made him horns of iron: and he said, Thus saith the LORD, With these shalt thou push the Syrians, until thou have consumed them.

Syrians unto the [13 1CH 19 14](#) # So Joab and the people that [were] with him drew nigh before the Syrians unto the battle; and they fled before him.

Syrians were fled [13 1CH 19 15](#) # And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, they likewise fled before Abishai his brother, and entered into the city. Then Joab came to Jerusalem.

Syrians were fled [10 2SA 10 14](#) # And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, then fled they also before Abishai, and entered into the city. So Joab returned from the children of Ammon, and came to Jerusalem.

Syrians with a [11 1KI 20 21](#) # And the king of Israel went out, and smote the horses and chariots, and slew the Syrians with a great slaughter.

Syrians wounded Joram [12 2KI 08 28](#) # And he went with Joram the son of Ahab to the war against Hazael king of Syria in Ramothgilead; and the Syrians wounded Joram.

Syrians [13 1CH 19 10](#) # Now when Joab saw that the battle was set against him before and behind, he chose out of all the choice of Israel, and put [them] in array against the Syrians.

Syrians [10 2SA 10 09](#) # When Joab saw that the front of the battle was against him before and behind, he chose of all the choice [men] of Israel, and put [them] in array against the Syrians:
