ambassador in bonds <u>49_EPH_06_20</u> # For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

ambassador is health <u>20_PRO_13_17</u># A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador [is] health.

ambassador is sent <u>24_JER_49_14</u> # I have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent unto the heathen, [saying], Gather ye together, and come against her, and rise up to the battle.

ambassador is sent <u>31_OBA_01_01</u> # The vision of Obadiah. Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning Edom; We have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle.

ambassadors and took <u>06_JOS_09_04</u># They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up;

ambassadors by the <u>23_ISA_18_02</u> # That sendeth ambassadors by the sea, even in vessels of bulrushes upon the waters, [saying], Go, ye swift messengers, to a nation scattered and peeled, to a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden down, whose land the rivers have spoiled!

ambassadors came to 23_ISA_30_04 # For his princes were at Zoan, and his ambassadors came to Hanes.

ambassadors for Christ <u>47_2CO_05_20</u> # Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech [you] by us: we pray [you] in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

ambassadors into Egypt <u>26_EZE_17_15</u># But he rebelled against him in sending his ambassadors into Egypt, that they might give him horses and much people. Shall he prosper? shall he escape that doeth such [things]? or shall he break the covenant, and be delivered?

ambassadors of peace <u>23_ISA_33_07</u> # Behold, their valiant ones shall cry without: the ambassadors of peace shall weep bitterly.

ambassadors of the <u>14_2CH_32_31</u># Howbeit in [the business of] the ambassadors of the princes of Babylon, who sent unto him to inquire of the wonder that was [done] in the land, God left him, to try him, that he might know all [that was] in his heart.

ambassadors to him <u>14_2CH_35_21</u> # But he sent ambassadors to him, saying, What have I to do with thee, thou king of Judah? [I come] not against thee this day, but against the house wherewith I have war: for God commanded me to make haste: forbear thee from [meddling with] God, who [is] with me, that he destroy thee not.

sad and strengthened <u>26_EZE_13_22</u># Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life:

sad at that <u>41_MAR_10_22</u> # And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.

sad countenance for <u>40_MAT_06_16</u># Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

sad in his <u>16_NEH_02_01</u> # And it came to pass in the month Nisan, in the twentieth year of Artaxerxes the king, [that] wine [was] before him: and I took up the wine, and gave [it] unto the king. Now I had not been [beforetime] sad in his presence.

sad seeing thou <u>16_NEH_02_02</u># Wherefore the king said unto me, Why [is] thy countenance sad, seeing thou [art] not sick? this [is] nothing [else] but sorrow of heart. Then I was very sore afraid,

sad that thou <u>11_1KI_21_05</u># But Jezebel his wife came to him, and said unto him, Why is thy spirit so sad, that thou eatest no bread?

sad when the <u>16_NEH_02_03</u># And said unto the king, Let the king live for ever: why should not my countenance be sad, when the city, the place of my fathers' sepulchres, [lieth] waste, and the gates thereof are consumed with fire?

sad whom I <u>26_EZE_13_22</u> # Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life:

sad <u>09_1SA_01_18</u># And she said, Let thine handmaid find grace in thy sight. So the woman went her way, and did eat, and her countenance was no more [sad].

sad <u>01_GEN_40_06</u># And Joseph came in unto them in the morning, and looked upon them, and, behold, they [were] sad.

sad <u>42_LUK_24_17</u># And he said unto them, What manner of communications [are] these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?

saddle me an <u>10_2SA_19_26</u> # And he answered, My lord, O king, my servant deceived me: for thy servant said, I will saddle me an ass, that I may ride thereon, and go to the king; because thy servant [is] lame.

Saddle me the <u>11_1KI_13_13</u># And he said unto his sons, Saddle me the ass. So they saddled him the ass: and he rode thereon,

Sadducees <u>40_MAT_16_11</u># How is it that ye do not understand that I spake [it] not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?

Sadducees <u>40_MAT_16_12</u># Then understood they how that he bade [them] not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.
