scribes and be <u>42_LUK_09_22</u> # Saying, The Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be slain, and be raised the third day.

scribes and be <u>41_MAR_08_31</u> # And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and [of] the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

scribes and be <u>40_MAT_16_21</u># From that time forth began Jesus to show unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.

scribes and came <u>44_ACT_06_12</u> # And they stirred up the people, and the elders, and the scribes, and came upon [him], and caught him, and brought [him] to the council,

scribes and chief <u>41_MAR_11_18</u># And the scribes and chief priests heard [it], and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.

scribes and elders <u>40_MAT_27_41</u># Likewise also the chief priests mocking [him], with the scribes and elders, said,

scribes and of <u>40_MAT_12_38</u># Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.

scribes and officers <u>14_2CH_34_13</u> # Also [they were] over the bearers of burdens, and [were] overseers of all that wrought the work in any manner of service: and of the Levites [there were] scribes, and officers, and porters.

scribes and Pharisees <u>43_JOH_08_03</u> # And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,

scribes and Pharisees <u>42_LUK_05_30</u> # But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?

scribes and Pharisees <u>42_LUK_06_07</u> # And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him.

scribes and Pharisees <u>42_LUK_11_44</u> # Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are as graves which appear not, and the men that walk over [them] are not aware [of them].

scribes and Pharisees <u>41_MAR_02_16</u> # And when the scribes and Pharisees saw him eat with publicans and sinners, they said unto his disciples, How is it that he eateth and drinketh with publicans and sinners?

scribes and Pharisees <u>40_MAT_05_20</u># For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed [the righteousness] of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40_MAT_15_01</u># Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,

scribes and Pharisees <u>40_MAT_23_13</u># But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in [yourselves], neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40 MAT_23 14</u> # Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40 MAT_23_15</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40_MAT_23_23</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier [matters] of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40_MAT_23_25</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40_MAT_23_27</u> # Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead [men's] bones, and of all uncleanness.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40_MAT_23_29</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,

scribes and some <u>40_MAT_23_34</u># Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and [some] of them ye shall kill and crucify; and [some] of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute [them] from city to city:

scribes and the <u>42_LUK_05_21</u> # And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?

scribes and the <u>42_LUK_11_53</u># And as he said these things unto them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to urge [him] vehemently, and to provoke him to speak of many things:

scribes and the <u>42_LUK_19_47</u># And he taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy him,

scribes and the <u>41_MAR_11_27</u># And they come again to Jerusalem: and as he was walking in the temple, there come to him the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders,

scribes and the <u>41_MAR_14_43</u># And immediately, while he yet spake, cometh Judas, one of the twelve, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and the scribes and the elders.

scribes and the <u>41_MAR_15_01</u> # And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.

scribes and the <u>40_MAT_23_02</u># Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat:

scribes and the <u>40_MAT_26_03</u># Then assembled together the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas,

scribes and the 40_MAT_26_57 # And they that had laid hold on Jesus led [him] away to Caiaphas the high

priest, where the scribes and the elders were assembled.

scribes and they <u>41_MAR_10_33</u># [Saying], Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes; and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles:

scribes and they <u>40_MAT_20_18</u># Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death,

scribes answering said <u>42_LUK_20_39</u> # Then certain of the scribes answering said, Master, thou hast well said.

scribes asked him <u>41_MAR_07_05</u># Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?

scribes called at <u>17_EST_08_09</u> # Then were the king's scribes called at that time in the third month, that [is], the month Sivan, on the three and twentieth [day] thereof; and it was written according to all that Mordecai commanded unto the Jews, and to the lieutenants, and the deputies and rulers of the provinces which [are] from India unto Ethiopia, an hundred twenty and seven provinces, unto every province according to the writing thereof, and unto every people after their language, and to the Jews according to their writing, and according to their language.

scribes called on <u>17_EST_03_12</u># Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that [were] over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according to the writing thereof, and [to] every people after their language; in the name of king Ahasuerus was it written, and sealed with the king's ring.

scribes came and <u>41_MAR_12_28</u># And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all?

scribes came together <u>42_LUK_22_66</u> # And as soon as it was day, the elders of the people and the chief priests and the scribes came together, and led him into their council, saying,

scribes came upon <u>42_LUK_20_01</u> # And it came to pass, [that] on one of those days, as he taught the people in the temple, and preached the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes came upon [him] with the elders,

scribes He saved <u>41_MAR_15_31</u> # Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others; himself he cannot save.

scribes is in <u>24_JER_08_08</u> # How do ye say, We [are] wise, and the law of the LORD [is] with us? Lo, certainly in vain made he [it]; the pen of the scribes [is] in vain.

scribes Jehoshaphat the <u>11_1KI_04_03</u># Elihoreph and Ahiah, the sons of Shisha, scribes; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder.

scribes murmured saying <u>42_LUK_15_02</u> # And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.

scribes of the <u>40_MAT_02_04</u># And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born.

scribes questioning with <u>41_MAR_09_14</u># And when he came to [his] disciples, he saw a great multitude

about them, and the scribes questioning with them.

scribes said within <u>40_MAT_09_03</u># And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This [man] blasphemeth.

scribes saw the <u>40_MAT_21_15</u># And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased,

scribes sitting there <u>41_MAR_02_06</u># But there were certain of the scribes sitting there, and reasoning in their hearts,

scribes sought how <u>42_LUK_22_02</u> # And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.

scribes sought how <u>41_MAR_14_01</u> # After two days was [the feast of] the passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put [him] to death.

scribes stood and <u>42_LUK_23_10</u># And the chief priests and scribes stood and vehemently accused him.

scribes that Christ <u>41_MAR_12_35</u> # And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the son of David?

scribes that Elias <u>41_MAR_09_11</u># And they asked him, saying, Why say the scribes that Elias must first come?

scribes that Elias <u>40_MAT_17_10</u># And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come?

scribes that were <u>44_ACT_23_09</u> # And there arose a great cry: and the scribes [that were] of the Pharisees' part arose, and strove, saying, We find no evil in this man: but if a spirit or an angel hath spoken to him, let us not fight against God.

scribes the same <u>42_LUK_20_19</u> # And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them.

scribes What question <u>41_MAR_09_16</u># And he asked the scribes, What question ye with them?

scribes which came <u>41_MAR_03_22</u> # And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils.

scribes which came <u>41_MAR_07_01</u># Then came together unto him the Pharisees, and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem.

scribes which desire <u>42_LUK_20_46</u> # Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;

scribes which dwelt <u>13_1CH_02_55</u> # And the families of the scribes which dwelt at Jabez; the Tirathites, the Shimeathites, [and] Suchathites. These [are] the Kenites that came of Hemath, the father of the house of Rechab.

scribes which love <u>41_MAR_12_38</u># And he said unto them in his doctrine, Beware of the scribes, which love to go in long clothing, and [love] salutations in the marketplaces,

scribes <u>44_ACT_04_05</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, that their rulers, and elders, and scribes,

scribes <u>41_MAR_01_22</u> # And they were astonished at his doctrine: for he taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.

scribes <u>41_MAR_14_53</u> # And they led Jesus away to the high priest: and with him were assembled all the chief priests and the elders and the scribes.

scribes <u>40_MAT_07_29</u># For he taught them as [one] having authority, and not as the scribes.
