sluggard is wiser [20 PRO 26 16](#) # The sluggard [is] wiser in his own conceit than seven men that can render a reason.

sluggard to them [20 PRO 10 26](#) # As vinegar to the teeth, and as smoke to the eyes, so [is] the sluggard to them that send him.

sluggard when wilt [20 PRO 06 09](#) # How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard? when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep?
