stedfast and every 58 HEB 02 02 # For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompense of reward;

stedfast and shalt 18 JOB 11 15# For then shalt thou lift up thy face without spot; yea, thou shalt be stedfast, and shalt not fear:

stedfast and which 58 HEB 06 19 # Which [hope] we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil:

stedfast for ever 27 DAN 06 26 #I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he [is] the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom [that] which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion [shall be even] unto the end.

stedfast in his 46 1CO 07 37 # Nevertheless he that standeth stedfast in his heart, having no necessity, but hath power over his own will, and hath so decreed in his heart that he will keep his virgin, doeth well.

stedfast in his 19 PSA 78 37 # For their heart was not right with him, neither were they stedfast in his covenant.

stedfast in the 60 1PE 05 09 # Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

stedfast knowing that 47_2CO 01_07 # And our hope of you [is] stedfast, knowing, that as ye are partakers of the sufferings, so [shall ye be] also of the consolation.

stedfast unmoveable always 46 1CO 15 58 # Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

stedfast unto the 58 HEB 03 14# For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

stedfast with God 19 PSA 78 08 # And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation [that] set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God.

stedfastly behold the 47 2CO 03 07 # But if the ministration of death, written [and] engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which [glory] was to be done away:

stedfastly beholding him 44 ACT 14 09 # The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,

stedfastly in the 44 ACT 02 42 # And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers,

stedfastly into heaven 44 ACT 07 55 # But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

stedfastly look to 47 2CO 03 13 # And not as Moses, [which] put a veil over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:

stedfastly minded to 08 RUT 01 18# When she saw that she was stedfastly minded to go with her, then she left speaking unto her.

stedfastly on him 44 ACT 06 15 # And all that sat in the council, looking stedfastly on him, saw his face as it had been the face of an angel.

stedfastly set his 42 LUK 09 51 # And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received up, he stedfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem,

stedfastly toward heaven 44 ACT 01 10 # And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;

stedfastly until he 12 2KI 08 11 # And he settled his countenance stedfastly, until he was ashamed: and the man of God wept.

stedfastness of your 51 COL 02 05 # For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

stedfastness 61 2PE 03 17 # Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know [these things] before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness.
