stoop but a [20\\_PRO\\_12\\_25](#) # Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.

stoop down and [41\\_MAR\\_01\\_07](#) # And preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose.

stoop they bow [23\\_ISA\\_46\\_02](#) # They stoop, they bow down together; they could not deliver the burden, but themselves are gone into captivity.

stoop under him [18\\_JOB\\_09\\_13](#) # [If] God will not withdraw his anger, the proud helpers do stoop under him.

stooped down and [43\\_JOH\\_08\\_06](#) # This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with [his] finger wrote on the ground, [as though he heard them not].

stooped down and [43\\_JOH\\_08\\_08](#) # And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.

stooped down and [43\\_JOH\\_20\\_11](#) # But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, [and looked] into the sepulchre,

stooped down he [01\\_GEN\\_49\\_09](#) # Judah [is] a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?

stooped for age [14\\_2CH\\_36\\_17](#) # Therefore he brought upon them the king of the Chaldees, who slew their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary, and had no compassion upon young man or maiden, old man, or him that stooped for age: he gave [them] all into his hand.

stooped with his [09\\_ISA\\_24\\_08](#) # David also arose afterward, and went out of the cave, and cried after Saul, saying, My lord the king. And when Saul looked behind him, David stooped with his face to the earth, and bowed himself.

stooped with his [09\\_ISA\\_28\\_14](#) # And he said unto her, What form [is] he of? And she said, An old man cometh up; and he [is] covered with a mantle. And Saul perceived that it [was] Samuel, and he stooped with [his] face to the ground, and bowed himself.

stoopeth their idols [23\\_ISA\\_46\\_01](#) # Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages [were] heavy loaden; [they are] a burden to the weary [beast].

stooping down and [43\\_JOH\\_20\\_05](#) # And he stooping down, [and looking in], saw the linen clothes lying; yet went he not in.

stooping down he [42\\_LUK\\_24\\_12](#) # Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.
