strangers and after [24 JER 02 25](#) # Withhold thy foot from being unshod, and thy throat from thirst: but thou saidst, There is no hope: no; for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go.

strangers and appointed [16 NEH 13 30](#) # Thus cleansed I them from all strangers, and appointed the wards of the priests and the Levites, every one in his business;

strangers and foreigners [49 EPH 02 19](#) # Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

strangers and pilgrims [60 1PE 02 11](#) # Dearly beloved, I beseech [you] as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

strangers and pilgrims [58 HEB 11 13](#) # These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of [them], and embraced [them], and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

strangers and sojourners [03 LEV 25 23](#) # The land shall not be sold for ever: for the land [is] mine; for ye [are] strangers and sojourners with me.

strangers and stood [16 NEH 09 02](#) # And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

strangers and will [26 EZE 11 09](#) # And I will bring you out of the midst thereof, and deliver you into the hands of strangers, and will execute judgments among you.

strangers are come [24 JER 51 51](#) # We are confounded, because we have heard reproach: shame hath covered our faces: for strangers are come into the sanctuaries of the LORD'S house.

strangers are risen [19 PSA 54 03](#) # For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors seek after my soul: they have not set God before them. Selah.

strangers as the [23 ISA 25 05](#) # Thou shalt bring down the noise of strangers, as the heat in a dry place; [even] the heat with the shadow of a cloud: the branch of the terrible ones shall be brought low.

strangers be filled [20 PRO 05 10](#) # Lest strangers be filled with thy wealth; and thy labours [be] in the house of a stranger;

strangers before thee [13 1CH 29 15](#) # For we [are] strangers before thee, and sojourners, as [were] all our fathers: our days on the earth [are] as a shadow, and [there is] none abiding.

strangers carried away [31 OBA 01 11](#) # In the day that thou stoodest on the other side, in the day that the strangers carried away captive his forces, and foreigners entered into his gates, and cast lots upon Jerusalem, even thou [wast] as one of them.

strangers could not [01 GEN 36 07](#) # For their riches were more than that they might dwell together; and the land wherein they were strangers could not bear them because of their cattle.

strangers devour it [23 ISA 01 07](#) # Your country [is] desolate, your cities [are] burned with fire: your land,

strangers devour it in your presence, and [it is] desolate, as overthrown by strangers.

strangers eat [23 ISA 05 17](#) # Then shall the lambs feed after their manner, and the waste places of the fat ones shall strangers eat.

strangers for a [26 EZE 07 21](#) # And I will give it into the hands of the strangers for a prey, and to the wicked of the earth for a spoil; and they shall pollute it.

strangers for he [01 GEN 31 15](#) # Are we not counted of him strangers? for he hath sold us, and hath quite devoured also our money.

strangers for I [26 EZE 28 10](#) # Thou shalt die the deaths of the uncircumcised by the hand of strangers: for I have spoken [it], saith the Lord GOD.

strangers for thereby [58 HEB 13 02](#) # Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

strangers from the [49 EPH 02 12](#) # That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

Strangers have devoured [28 HOS 07 09](#) # Strangers have devoured his strength, and he knoweth [it] not: yea, gray hairs are here and there upon him, yet he knoweth not.

strangers he relieveth [19 PSA 146 09](#) # The LORD preserveth the strangers; he relieveth the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked he turneth upside down.

strangers I the [26 EZE 30 12](#) # And I will make the rivers dry, and sell the land into the hand of the wicked: and I will make the land waste, and all that is therein, by the hand of strangers: I the LORD have spoken [it].

strangers if she [54 1TI 05 10](#) # Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work.

strangers in a [24 JER 05 19](#) # And it shall come to pass, when ye shall say, Wherefore doeth the LORD our God all these [things] unto us? then shalt thou answer them, Like as ye have forsaken me, and served strange gods in your land, so shall ye serve strangers in a land [that is] not yours.

strangers in Israel [03 LEV 22 18](#) # Speak unto Aaron, and to his sons, and unto all the children of Israel, and say unto them, Whatsoever [he be] of the house of Israel, or of the strangers in Israel, that will offer his oblation for all his vows, and for all his freewill offerings, which they will offer unto the LORD for a burnt offering;

strangers in it [13 1CH 16 19](#) # When ye were but few, even a few, and strangers in it.

strangers in it [19 PSA 105 12](#) # When they were [but] a few men in number; yea, very few, and strangers in it.

strangers in the [44 ACT 13 17](#) # The God of this people of Israel chose our fathers, and exalted the people when they dwelt as strangers in the land of Egypt, and with an high arm brought he them out of it.

strangers in the [05 DEU 10 19](#) # Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

strangers in the [02_EXO_22_21](#) # Thou shalt neither vex a stranger, nor oppress him: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

strangers in the [02_EXO_23_09](#) # Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger: for ye know the heart of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

strangers in the [03_LEV_19_34](#) # [But] the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.

strangers in [40_MAT_27_07](#) # And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

strangers instead of [26_EZE_16_32](#) # [But as] a wife that committeth adultery, [which] taketh strangers instead of her husband!

strangers Jesus saith [40_MAT_17_26](#) # Peter saith unto him, Of strangers. Jesus saith unto him, Then are the children free.

strangers of Rome [44_ACT_02_10](#) # Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes,

strangers of the [05_DEU_31_16](#) # And the LORD said unto Moses, Behold, thou shalt sleep with thy fathers; and this people will rise up, and go a whoring after the gods of the strangers of the land, whither they go [to be] among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them.

strangers our houses [25_LAM_05_02](#) # Our inheritance is turned to strangers, our houses to aliens.

strangers pass through [29_JOE_03_17](#) # So shall ye know that I [am] the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.

strangers scattered throughout [60_1PE_01_01](#) # Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,

strangers shall be [23_ISA_14_01](#) # For the LORD will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them, and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.

strangers shall fade [19_PSA_18_45](#) # The strangers shall fade away, and be afraid out of their close places.

strangers shall no [24_JER_30_08](#) # For it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, [that] I will break his yoke from off thy neck, and will burst thy bonds, and strangers shall no more serve themselves of him:

strangers shall stand [23_ISA_61_05](#) # And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien [shall be] your plowmen and your vinedressers.

Strangers shall submit [10 2SA 22 45](#) # Strangers shall submit themselves unto me: as soon as they hear, they shall be obedient unto me.

strangers shall submit [19 PSA 18 44](#) # As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me.

strangers shall swallow [28 HOS 08 07](#) # For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind: it hath no stalk: the bud shall yield no meal: if so be it yield, the strangers shall swallow it up.

strangers spoil his [19 PSA 109 11](#) # Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour.

strangers that are [05 DEU 24 14](#) # Thou shalt not oppress an hired servant [that is] poor and needy, [whether he be] of thy brethren, or of thy strangers that [are] in thy land within thy gates:

strangers that came [14 2CH 30 25](#) # And all the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, rejoiced.

strangers that do [03 LEV 25 45](#) # Moreover of the children of the strangers that do sojourn among you, of them shall ye buy, and of their families that [are] with you, which they begat in your land: and they shall be your possession.

strangers that sojourn [26 EZE 47 22](#) # And it shall come to pass, [that] ye shall divide it by lot for an inheritance unto you, and to the strangers that sojourn among you, which shall beget children among you: and they shall be unto you as born in the country among the children of Israel; they shall have inheritance with you among the tribes of Israel.

strangers that sojourn [03 LEV 17 10](#) # And whatsoever man [there be] of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of blood; I will even set my face against that soul that eateth blood, and will cut him off from among his people.

strangers that sojourn [03 LEV 20 02](#) # Again, thou shalt say to the children of Israel, Whosoever [he be] of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn in Israel, that giveth [any] of his seed unto Molech; he shall surely be put to death: the people of the land shall stone him with stones.

strangers that were [13 1CH 22 02](#) # And David commanded to gather together the strangers that [were] in the land of Israel; and he set masons to hew wrought stones to build the house of God.

strangers that were [14 2CH 02 17](#) # And Solomon numbered all the strangers that [were] in the land of Israel, after the numbering wherewith David his father had numbered them; and they were found an hundred and fifty thousand and three thousand and six hundred.

strangers that were [06 JOS 08 35](#) # There was not a word of all that Moses commanded, which Joshua read not before all the congregation of Israel, with the women, and the little ones, and the strangers that were conversant among them.

strangers the terrible [26 EZE 31 12](#) # And strangers, the terrible of the nations, have cut him off, and have left him: upon the mountains and in all the valleys his branches are fallen, and his boughs are broken by all the rivers of the land; and all the people of the earth are gone down from his shadow, and have left

him.

strangers to be [23 ISA 25 02](#) # For thou hast made of a city an heap; [of] a defenced city a ruin: a palace of strangers to be no city; it shall never be built.

strangers uncircumcised in [26 EZE 44 07](#) # In that ye have brought [into my sanctuary] strangers, uncircumcised in heart, and uncircumcised in flesh, to be in my sanctuary, to pollute it, [even] my house, when ye offer my bread, the fat and the blood, and they have broken my covenant because of all your abominations.

strangers under every [24 JER 03 13](#) # Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the LORD.

strangers upon thee [26 EZE 28 07](#) # Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon thee, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of thy wisdom, and they shall defile thy brightness.

strangers which sojourn [03 LEV 17 08](#) # And thou shalt say unto them, Whatsoever man [there be] of the house of Israel, or of the strangers which sojourn among you, that offereth a burnt offering or sacrifice,

strangers which were [44 ACT 17 21](#) # [For all the Athenians and strangers which were there spent their time in nothing else, but either to tell, or to hear some new thing.]

strangers with thee [20 PRO 05 17](#) # Let them be only thine own, and not strangers' with thee.

strangers with them [14 2CH 15 09](#) # And he gathered all Judah and Benjamin, and the strangers with them out of Ephraim and Manasseh, and out of Simeon: for they fell to him out of Israel in abundance, when they saw that the LORD his God [was] with him.

strangers [64 3JO 01 05](#) # Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

strangers [02 EXO 06 04](#) # And I have also established my covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, wherein they were strangers.

strangers [23 ISA 01 07](#) # Your country [is] desolate, your cities [are] burned with fire: your land, strangers devour it in your presence, and [it is] desolate, as overthrown by strangers.

strangers [23 ISA 02 06](#) # Therefore thou hast forsaken thy people the house of Jacob, because they be replenished from the east, and [are] soothsayers like the Philistines, and they please themselves in the children of strangers.

strangers [24 JER 35 07](#) # Neither shall ye build house, nor sow seed, nor plant vineyard, nor have [any]: but all your days ye shall dwell in tents; that ye may live many days in the land where ye [be] strangers.

strangers [43 JOH 10 05](#) # And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.

strangers [40 MAT 17 25](#) # He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?
