stare upon me [19_PSA_22_17](#) # I may tell all my bones: they look [and] stare upon me.

tare forty and [12_2KI_02_24](#) # And he turned back, and looked on them, and cursed them in the name of the LORD. And there came forth two she bears out of the wood, and tare forty and two children of them.

tare him And [42_LUK_09_42](#) # And as he was yet a coming, the devil threw him down, and tare [him]. And Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, and healed the child, and delivered him again to his father.
