Baaltamar and the [07 JUD 20 33](#) # And all the men of Israel rose up out of their place, and put themselves in array at Baaltamar: and the liers in wait of Israel came forth out of their places, [even] out of the meadows of Gibeah.

Hazazontamar which is [14 2CH 20 02](#) # Then there came some that told Jehoshaphat, saying, There cometh a great multitude against thee from beyond the sea on this side Syria; and, behold, they [be] in Hazazontamar, which [is] Engedi.

Hazazontamar [01 GEN 14 07](#) # And they returned, and came to Enmishpat, which [is] Kadesh, and smote all the country of the Amalekites, and also the Amorites, that dwelt in Hazazontamar.

Tamar and Amnon [10 2SA 13 01](#) # And it came to pass after this, that Absalom the son of David had a fair sister, whose name [was] Tamar; and Amnon the son of David loved her.

Tamar bare unto [08 RUT 04 12](#) # And let thy house be like the house of Pharez, whom Tamar bare unto Judah, of the seed which the LORD shall give thee of this young woman.

Tamar Bring the [10 2SA 13 10](#) # And Amnon said unto Tamar, Bring the meat into the chamber, that I may eat of thine hand. And Tamar took the cakes which she had made, and brought [them] into the chamber to Amnon her brother.

Tamar for she [10 2SA 13 02](#) # And Amnon was so vexed, that he fell sick for his sister Tamar; for she [was] a virgin; and Amnon thought it hard for him to do any thing to her.

Tamar his daughter [13 1CH 02 04](#) # And Tamar his daughter in law bare him Pharez and Zerah. All the sons of Judah [were] five.

Tamar his daughter [01 GEN 38 11](#) # Then said Judah to Tamar his daughter in law, Remain a widow at thy father's house, till Shelah my son be grown: for he said, Lest peradventure he die also, as his brethren [did]. And Tamar went and dwelt in her father's house.

Tamar my brother [10 2SA 13 04](#) # And he said unto him, Why [art] thou, [being] the king's son, lean from day to day? wilt thou not tell me? And Amnon said unto him, I love Tamar, my brother Absalom's sister.

Tamar my sister [10 2SA 13 06](#) # So Amnon lay down, and made himself sick: and when the king was come to see him, Amnon said unto the king, I pray thee, let Tamar my sister come, and make me a couple of cakes in my sight, that I may eat at her hand.

Tamar put ashes [10 2SA 13 19](#) # And Tamar put ashes on her head, and rent her garment of divers colours that [was] on her, and laid her hand on her head, and went on crying.

Tamar remained desolate [10 2SA 13 20](#) # And Absalom her brother said unto her, Hath Amnon thy brother been with thee? but hold now thy peace, my sister: he [is] thy brother; regard not this thing. So Tamar remained desolate in her brother Absalom's house.

Tamar saying Behold [01 GEN 38 13](#) # And it was told Tamar, saying, Behold thy father in law goeth up to Timnath to shear his sheep.

Tamar saying Go [10 2SA 13 07](#) # Then David sent home to Tamar, saying, Go now to thy brother Amnon's house, and dress him meat.

Tamar she was [10 2SA 14 27](#) # And unto Absalom there were born three sons, and one daughter, whose name [was] Tamar: she was a woman of a fair countenance.

Tamar their sister [13 1CH 03 09](#) # [These were] all the sons of David, beside the sons of the concubines, and Tamar their sister.

Tamar thy daughter [01 GEN 38 24](#) # And it came to pass about three months after, that it was told Judah, saying, Tamar thy daughter in law hath played the harlot; and also, behold, she [is] with child by whoredom. And Judah said, Bring her forth, and let her be burnt.

Tamar took the [10 2SA 13 10](#) # And Amnon said unto Tamar, Bring the meat into the chamber, that I may eat of thine hand. And Tamar took the cakes which she had made, and brought [them] into the chamber to Amnon her brother.

Tamar unto the [26 EZE 48 28](#) # And by the border of Gad, at the south side southward, the border shall be even from Tamar [unto] the waters of strife [in] Kadesh, [and] to the river toward the great sea.

Tamar [10 2SA 13 22](#) # And Absalom spake unto his brother Amnon neither good nor bad: for Absalom hated Amnon, because he had forced his sister Tamar.

Tamar [10 2SA 13 32](#) # And Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's brother, answered and said, Let not my lord suppose [that] they have slain all the young men the king's sons; for Amnon only is dead: for by the appointment of Absalom this hath been determined from the day that he forced his sister Tamar.

Tamar [01 GEN 38 06](#) # And Judah took a wife for Er his firstborn, whose name [was] Tamar.
