Tirzah and came [12 2KI 15 14](#) # For Menahem the son of Gadi went up from Tirzah, and came to Samaria, and smote Shallum the son of Jabesh in Samaria, and slew him, and reigned in his stead.

Tirzah and Elah [11 1KI 16 06](#) # So Baasha slept with his fathers, and was buried in Tirzah: and Elah his son reigned in his stead.

Tirzah and Hoglah [04 NUM 36 11](#) # For Mahlah, Tirzah, and Hoglah, and Milcah, and Noah, the daughters of Zelophehad, were married unto their father's brothers' sons:

Tirzah And the [11 1KI 16 15](#) # In the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people [were] encamped against Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines.

Tirzah and when [11 1KI 14 17](#) # And Jeroboam's wife arose, and departed, and came to Tirzah: [and] when she came to the threshold of the door, the child died;

Tirzah because they [12 2KI 15 16](#) # Then Menahem smote Tiphshah, and all that [were] therein, and the coasts thereof from Tirzah: because they opened not [to him], therefore he smote [it; and] all the women therein that were with child he ripped up.

Tirzah comely as [22 SON 06 04](#) # Thou [art] beautiful, O my love, as Tirzah, comely as Jerusalem, terrible as [an army] with banners.

Tirzah drinking himself [11 1KI 16 09](#) # And his servant Zimri, captain of half [his] chariots, conspired against him, as he was in Tirzah, drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza steward of [his] house in Tirzah.

Tirzah one all [06 JOS 12 24](#) # The king of Tirzah, one: all the kings thirty and one.

Tirzah twenty and [11 1KI 15 33](#) # In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty and four years.

Tirzah two years [11 1KI 16 08](#) # In the twenty and sixth year of Asa king of Judah began Elah the son of Baasha to reign over Israel in Tirzah, two years.

Tirzah [11 1KI 15 21](#) # And it came to pass, when Baasha heard [thereof], that he left off building of Ramah, and dwelt in Tirzah.

Tirzah [11 1KI 16 09](#) # And his servant Zimri, captain of half [his] chariots, conspired against him, as he was in Tirzah, drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza steward of [his] house in Tirzah.

Tirzah [11 1KI 16 17](#) # And Omri went up from Gibbethon, and all Israel with him, and they besieged Tirzah.

Tirzah [11 1KI 16 23](#) # In the thirty and first year of Asa king of Judah began Omri to reign over Israel, twelve years: six years reigned he in Tirzah.

Tirzah [06 JOS 17 03](#) # But Zelophehad, the son of Hepher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, had no sons, but daughters: and these [are] the names of his daughters, Mahlah, and Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah.

Tirzah [04 NUM 26 33](#) # And Zelophehad the son of Hepher had no sons, but daughters: and the names of the daughters of Zelophehad [were] Mahlah, and Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah.

Tirzah [04 NUM 27 01](#) # Then came the daughters of Zelophehad, the son of Hepher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, of the families of Manasseh the son of Joseph: and these [are] the names of his daughters; Mahlah, Noah, and Hoglah, and Milcah, and Tirzah.
