taking a far [41 MAR 13 34](#) # [For the Son of man is] as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.

taking heed thereto [19 PSA 119 09](#) # BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed [thereto] according to thy word.

taking him up [42 LUK 04 05](#) # And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, showed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

taking my leave [47 2CO 02 13](#) # I had no rest in my spirit, because I found not Titus my brother: but taking my leave of them, I went from thence into Macedonia.

taking nothing of [64 3JO 01 07](#) # Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.

taking occasion by [45 ROM 07 08](#) # But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin [was] dead.

taking occasion by [45 ROM 07 11](#) # For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew [me].

taking of Babylon [24 JER 50 46](#) # At the noise of the taking of Babylon the earth is moved, and the cry is heard among the nations.

taking the oversight [60 1PE 05 02](#) # Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight [thereof], not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

taking the shield [49 EPH 06 16](#) # Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

taking them by [28 HOS 11 03](#) # I taught Ephraim also to go, taking them by their arms; but they knew not that I healed them.

taking thought can [42 LUK 12 25](#) # And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit?
