tarried a little [08 RUT 02 07](#) # And she said, I pray you, let me glean and gather after the reapers among the sheaves: so she came, and hath continued even from the morning until now, that she tarried a little in the house.

tarried all night [01 GEN 24 54](#) # And they did eat and drink, he and the men that [were] with him, and tarried all night; and they rose up in the morning, and he said, Send me away unto my master.

tarried all night [01 GEN 31 54](#) # Then Jacob offered sacrifice upon the mount, and called his brethren to eat bread: and they did eat bread, and tarried all night in the mount.

tarried among them [44 ACT 25 06](#) # And when he had tarried among them more than ten days, he went down unto Caesarea; and the next day sitting on the judgment seat commanded Paul to be brought.

tarried and continued [44 ACT 27 33](#) # And while the day was coming on, Paul besought [them] all to take meat, saying, This day is the fourteenth day that ye have tarried and continued fasting, having taken nothing.

tarried and passed [07 JUD 03 26](#) # And Ehud escaped while they tarried, and passed beyond the quarries, and escaped unto Seirath.

tarried at home [19 PSA 68 12](#) # Kings of armies did flee apace: and she that tarried at home divided the spoil.

tarried at Jericho [12 2KI 02 18](#) # And when they came again to him, [for he tarried at Jericho,] he said unto them, Did I not say unto you, Go not?

tarried at Jerusalem [13 1CH 20 01](#) # And it came to pass, that after the year was expired, at the time that kings go out [to battle], Joab led forth the power of the army, and wasted the country of the children of Ammon, and came and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried at Jerusalem. And Joab smote Rabbah, and destroyed it.

tarried at Trogyllium [44 ACT 20 15](#) # And we sailed thence, and came the next [day] over against Chios; and the next [day] we arrived at Samos, and tarried at Trogyllium; and the next [day] we came to Miletus.

tarried behind in [42 LUK 02 43](#) # And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not [of it].

tarried for us [44 ACT 20 05](#) # These going before tarried for us at Troas.

tarried in a [10 2SA 15 17](#) # And the king went forth, and all the people after him, and tarried in a place that was far off.

tarried in the [09 1SA 14 02](#) # And Saul tarried in the uttermost part of Gibeah under a pomegranate tree which [is] in Migron: and the people that [were] with him [were] about six hundred men;

tarried long upon [04 NUM 09 19](#) # And when the cloud tarried long upon the tabernacle many days, then the children of Israel kept the charge of the LORD, and journeyed not.

tarried longer than [10 2SA 20 05](#) # So Amasa went to assemble [the men of] Judah: but he tarried longer than the set time which he had appointed him.

tarried many days [44 ACT 09 43](#) # And it came to pass, that he tarried many days in Joppa with one Simon a tanner.

tarried seven days [09 1SA 13 08](#) # And he tarried seven days, according to the set time that Samuel [had appointed]: but Samuel came not to Gilgal; and the people were scattered from him.

tarried so long [42 LUK 01 21](#) # And the people waited for Zacharias, and marvelled that he tarried so long in the temple.

tarried still at [10 2SA 11 01](#) # And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth [to battle], that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem.

tarried there a [44 ACT 15 33](#) # And after they had tarried [there] a space, they were let go in peace from the brethren unto the apostles.

tarried there all [01 GEN 28 11](#) # And he lighted upon a certain place, and tarried there all night, because the sun was set; and he took of the stones of that place, and put [them for] his pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep.

tarried there many [44 ACT 21 10](#) # And as we tarried [there] many days, there came down from Judaea a certain prophet, named Agabus.

tarried there seven [44 ACT 21 04](#) # And finding disciples, we tarried there seven days: who said to Paul through the Spirit, that he should not go up to Jerusalem.

tarried there three [44 ACT 28 12](#) # And landing at Syracuse, we tarried [there] three days.

tarried there yet [44 ACT 18 18](#) # And Paul [after this] tarried [there] yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn [his] head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.

tarried there [10 2SA 15 29](#) # Zadok therefore and Abiathar carried the ark of God again to Jerusalem: and they tarried there.

tarried they all [40 MAT 25 05](#) # While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.

tarried till they [07 JUD 03 25](#) # And they tarried till they were ashamed: and, behold, he opened not the doors of the parlour; therefore they took a key, and opened [them]: and, behold, their lord [was] fallen down dead on the earth.

tarried until afternoon [07 JUD 19 08](#) # And he arose early in the morning on the fifth day to depart: and the damsel's father said, Comfort thine heart, I pray thee. And they tarried until afternoon, and they did eat both of them.

tarried upon the [04 NUM 09 22](#) # Or [whether it were] two days, or a month, or a year, that the cloud tarried upon the tabernacle, remaining thereon, the children of Israel abode in their tents, and journeyed not: but when it was taken up, they journeyed.

tarried with them [43 JOH 03 22](#) # After these things came Jesus and his disciples into the land of Judaea; and there he tarried with them, and baptized.
