thieves also which [40 MAT 27 44](#) # The thieves also, which were crucified with him, cast the same in his teeth.

thieves and robbers [43 JOH 10 08](#) # All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them.

thieves break through [40 MAT 06 19](#) # Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

thieves by night [24 JER 49 09](#) # If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave [some] gleaning grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.

thieves came to [31 OBA 01 05](#) # If thieves came to thee, if robbers by night, [how art thou cut off!] would they not have stolen till they had enough? if the grapegatherers came to thee, would they not leave [some] grapes?

thieves crucified with [40 MAT 27 38](#) # Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left.

thieves do not [40 MAT 06 20](#) # But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

thieves every one [23 ISA 01 23](#) # Thy princes [are] rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one loveth gifts, and followeth after rewards: they judge not the fatherless, neither doth the cause of the widow come unto them.

thieves for since [24 JER 48 27](#) # For was not Israel a derision unto thee? was he found among thieves? for since thou spakest of him, thou skippest for joy.

thieves nor covetous [46 ICO 06 10](#) # Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

thieves the one [41 MAR 15 27](#) # And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left.

thieves which stripped [42 LUK 10 30](#) # And Jesus answering said, A certain [man] went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded [him], and departed, leaving [him] half dead.

thieves [42 LUK 10 36](#) # Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?

thieves [42 LUK 19 46](#) # Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.

thieves [41 MAR 11 17](#) # And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.

thieves [40 MAT 21 13](#) # And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
