thought of thine [44 ACT 08 22](#) # Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

thought of thy [19 PSA 48 09](#) # We have thought of thy lovingkindness, O God, in the midst of thy temple.

thought on my [19 PSA 119 59](#) # I thought on my ways, and turned my feet unto thy testimonies.

thought on the [44 ACT 10 19](#) # While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee.

thought on these [40 MAT 01 20](#) # But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

thought saying What [40 MAT 06 31](#) # Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

thought scorn to [17 EST 03 06](#) # And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had showed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that [were] throughout the whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, [even] the people of Mordecai.

thought she had [09 ISA 01 13](#) # Now Hannah, she spake in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she had been drunken.

thought so shall [23 ISA 14 24](#) # The LORD of hosts hath sworn, saying, Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposed, [so] shall it stand:

thought Something hath [09 ISA 20 26](#) # Nevertheless Saul spake not any thing that day: for he thought, Something hath befallen him, he [is] not clean; surely he [is] not clean.

thought such a [10 2SA 14 13](#) # And the woman said, Wherefore then hast thou thought such a thing against the people of God? for the king doth speak this thing as one which is faulty, in that the king doth not fetch home again his banished.

thought Surely the [01 GEN 20 11](#) # And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the fear of God [is] not

in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake.

thought that he [43 JOH 11 13](#) # Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep.
