overthrown and are <u>20\_PRO\_12\_07</u># The wicked are overthrown, and [are] not: but the house of the righteous shall stand.

overthrown and wounded <u>07\_JUD\_09\_40</u># And Abimelech chased him, and he fled before him, and many were overthrown [and] wounded, [even] unto the entering of the gate.

overthrown as in <u>25 LAM\_04\_06</u># For the punishment of the iniquity of the daughter of my people is greater than the punishment of the sin of Sodom, that was overthrown as in a moment, and no hands stayed on her.

overthrown at the <u>10\_2SA\_17\_09</u># Behold, he is hid now in some pit, or in some [other] place: and it will come to pass, when some of them be overthrown at the first, that whosoever heareth it will say, There is a slaughter among the people that follow Absalom.
