thyself a glorious [23 ISA 63 14](#) # As a beast goeth down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name.

thyself a man [11 1KI 02 02](#) # I go the way of all the earth: be thou strong therefore, and show thyself a man;

thyself a pattern [56 TIT 02 07](#) # In all things showing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine [showing] uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,

thyself abroad thou [05 DEU 23 13](#) # And thou shalt have a paddle upon thy weapon; and it shall be, when thou wilt ease thyself abroad, thou shalt dig therewith, and shalt turn back and cover that which cometh from thee:

thyself against me [10 2SA 18 13](#) # Otherwise I should have wrought falsehood against mine own life: for there is no matter hid from the king, and thou thyself wouldest have set thyself against [me].
