emptied And all [16 NEH 05 13](#) # Also I shook my lap, and said, So God shake out every man from his house, and from his labour, that performeth not this promise, even thus be he shaken out, and emptied. And all the congregation said, Amen, and praised the LORD. And the people did according to this promise.

emptied and dried [23 ISA 19 06](#) # And they shall turn the rivers far away; [and] the brooks of defence shall be emptied and dried up: the reeds and flags shall wither.

emptied and utterly [23 ISA 24 03](#) # The land shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled: for the LORD hath spoken this word.

emptied from vessel [24 JER 48 11](#) # Moab hath been at ease from his youth, and he hath settled on his lees, and hath not been emptied from vessel to vessel, neither hath he gone into captivity: therefore his taste remained in him, and his scent is not changed.

emptied her pitcher [01 GEN 24 20](#) # And she hasted, and emptied her pitcher into the trough, and ran again unto the well to draw [water], and drew for all his camels.

emptied the chest [14 2CH 24 11](#) # Now it came to pass, that at what time the chest was brought unto the king's office by the hand of the Levites, and when they saw that [there was] much money, the king's scribe and the high priest's officer came and emptied the chest, and took it, and carried it to his place again.
