travel they rushed <u>44\_ACT\_19\_29</u># And the whole city was filled with confusion: and having caught Gaius and Aristarchus, men of Macedonia, Paul's companions in travel, they rushed with one accord into the theatre.

travel with us <u>47\_2CO\_08\_19</u> # And not [that] only, but who was also chosen of the churches to travel with us with this grace, which is administered by us to the glory of the same Lord, and [declaration of] your ready mind:

travelled as far <u>44\_ACT\_11\_19</u># Now they which were scattered abroad upon the persecution that arose about Stephen travelled as far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to none but unto the Jews only.

traveller unto the <u>10\_2SA\_12\_04</u># And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

traveller 18\_JOB\_31\_32 # The stranger did not lodge in the street: [but] I opened my doors to the traveller.

travellers walked through <u>07\_JUD\_05\_06</u># In the days of Shamgar the son of Anath, in the days of Jael, the highways were unoccupied, and the travellers walked through byways.

travelleth and thy <u>20\_PRO\_06\_11</u># So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth, and thy want as an armed man.

travelleth and thy <u>20\_PRO\_24\_34</u># So shall thy poverty come [as] one that travelleth; and thy want as an armed man.

travelling companies of 23\_ISA\_21\_13 # The burden upon Arabia. In the forest in Arabia shall ye lodge, O ye travelling companies of Dedanim.

travelling in the <u>23\_ISA\_63\_01</u> # Who [is] this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this [that is] glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

travelling into a <u>40\_MAT\_25\_14</u># For [the kingdom of heaven is] as a man travelling into a far country, [who] called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.
