returned the child <u>42\_LUK\_02\_43</u># And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not [of it].

turned again and <u>06\_JOS\_08\_21</u> # And when Joshua and all Israel saw that the ambush had taken the city, and that the smoke of the city ascended, then they turned again, and slew the men of Ai.

turned again and <u>07\_JUD\_08\_33</u># And it came to pass, as soon as Gideon was dead, that the children of Israel turned again, and went a whoring after Baalim, and made Baalberith their god.

turned again as <u>02\_EXO\_04\_07</u># And he said, Put thine hand into thy bosom again. And he put his hand into his bosom again; and plucked it out of his bosom, and, behold, it was turned again as his [other] flesh.

turned again from 12 2KI 05 26 # And he said unto him, Went not mine heart [with thee], when the man turned again from his chariot to meet thee? [Is it] a time to receive money, and to receive garments, and oliveyards, and vineyards, and sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and maidservants?

turned again from <u>07\_JUD\_03\_19</u># But he himself turned again from the quarries that [were] by Gilgal, and said, I have a secret errand unto thee, O king: who said, Keep silence. And all that stood by him went out from him.

seek ye? They said unto him, Rabbi, [which is to say, being interpreted, Master,] where dwellest thou?

turned and took <u>05\_DEU\_02\_01</u># Then we turned, and took our journey into the wilderness by the way of the Red sea, as the LORD spake unto me: and we compassed mount Seir many days.

turned into paleness <u>24\_JER\_30\_06</u># Ask ye now, and see whether a man doth travail with child? wherefore do I see every man with his hands on his loins, as a woman in travail, and all faces are turned into paleness?

turned them away 24\_JER\_50\_06 # My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away [on] the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

turnest man to 19\_PSA\_90\_03 # Thou turnest man to destruction; and sayest, Return, ye children of men.

turnest thy spirit <u>18\_JOB\_15\_13</u># That thou turnest thy spirit against God, and lettest [such] words go out of thy mouth?

turnest thyself <u>11\_1KI\_02\_03</u># And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

turneth about unto <u>21\_ECC\_01\_06</u># The wind goeth toward the south, and turneth about unto the north; it whirleth about continually, and the wind returneth again according to his circuits.

turneth after such 03\_LEV\_20\_06 # And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after

turneth not away 20\_PRO\_30\_30\_# A lion [which is] strongest among beasts, and turneth not away for any;
