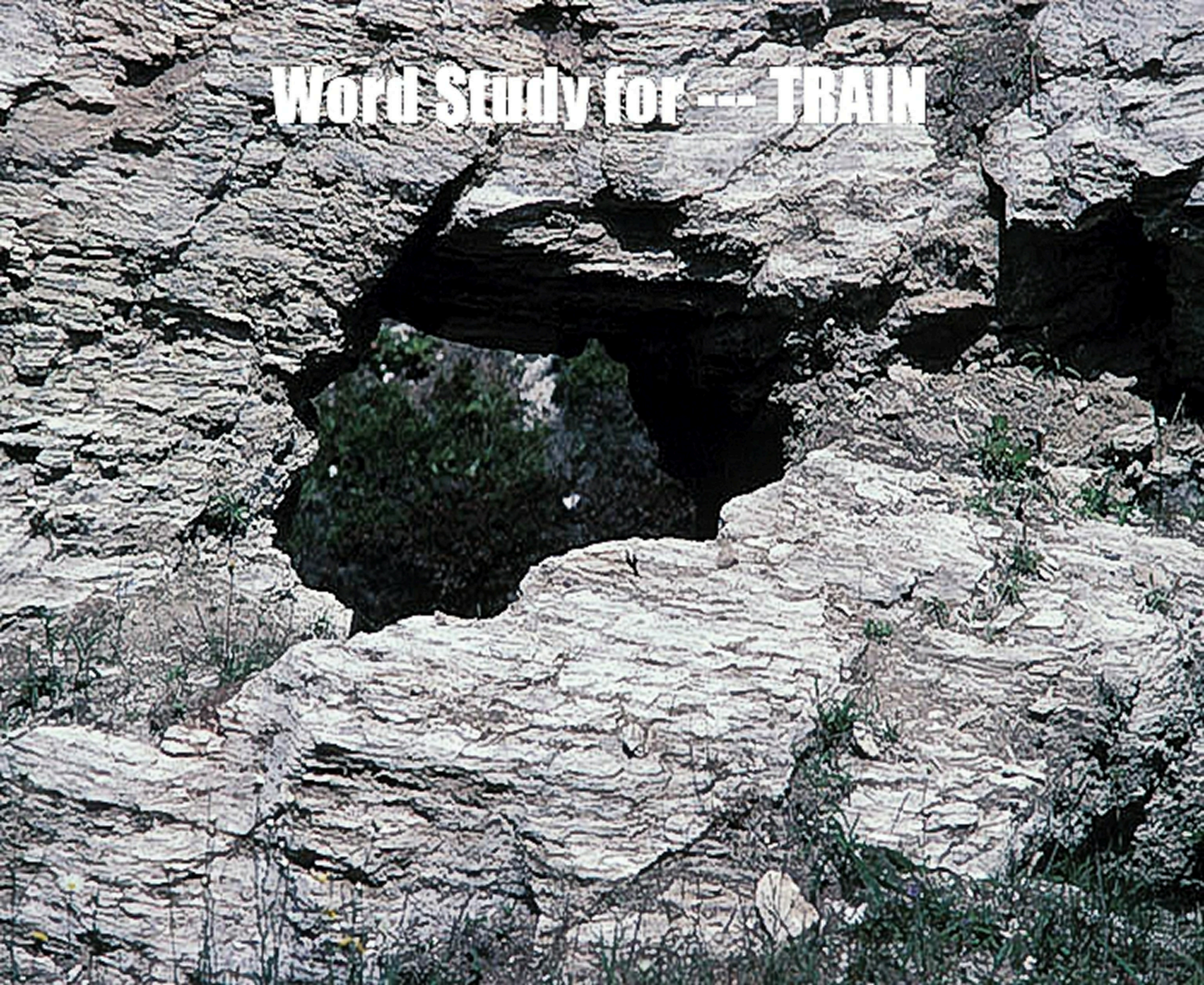



Word Study for --- TRAIN
