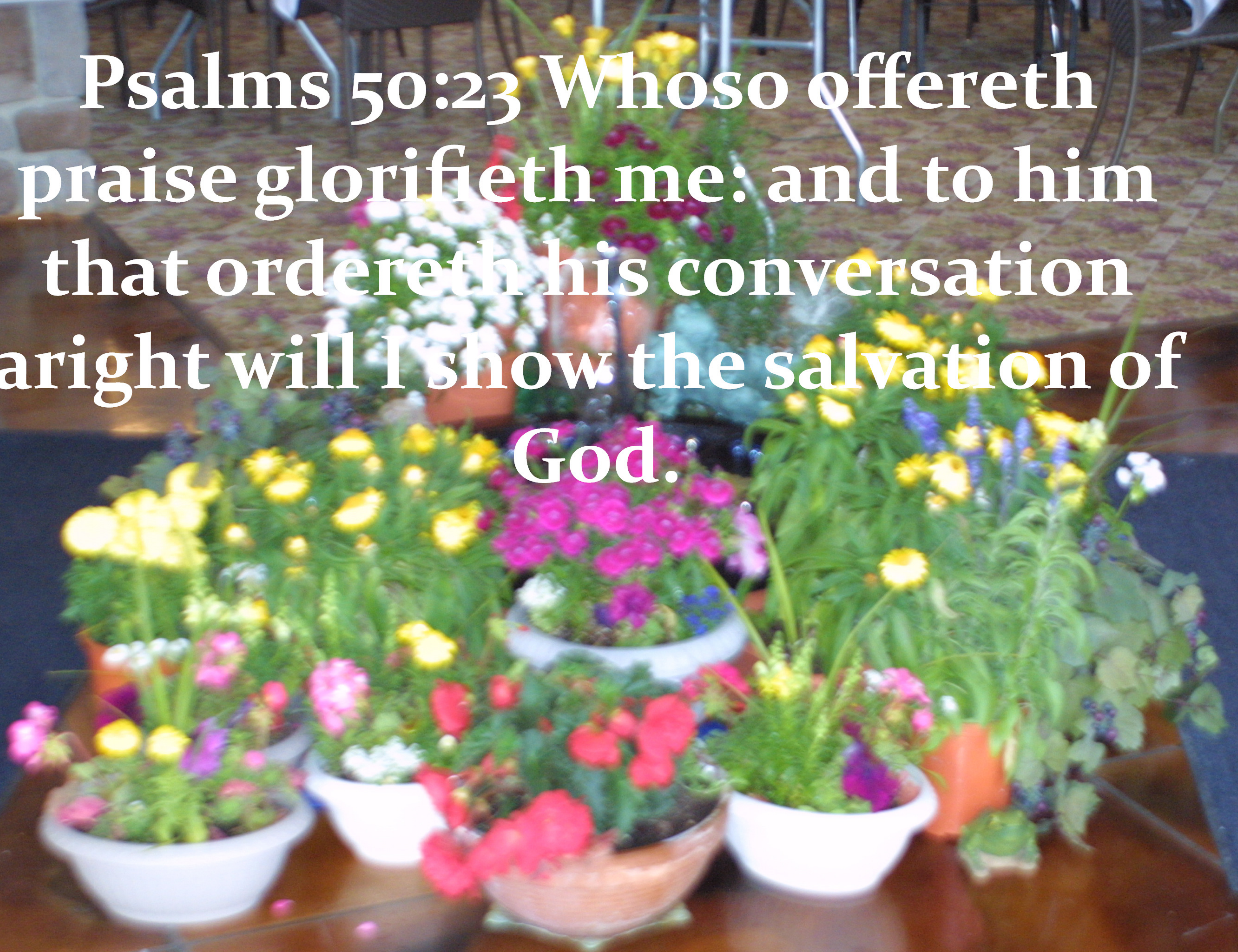


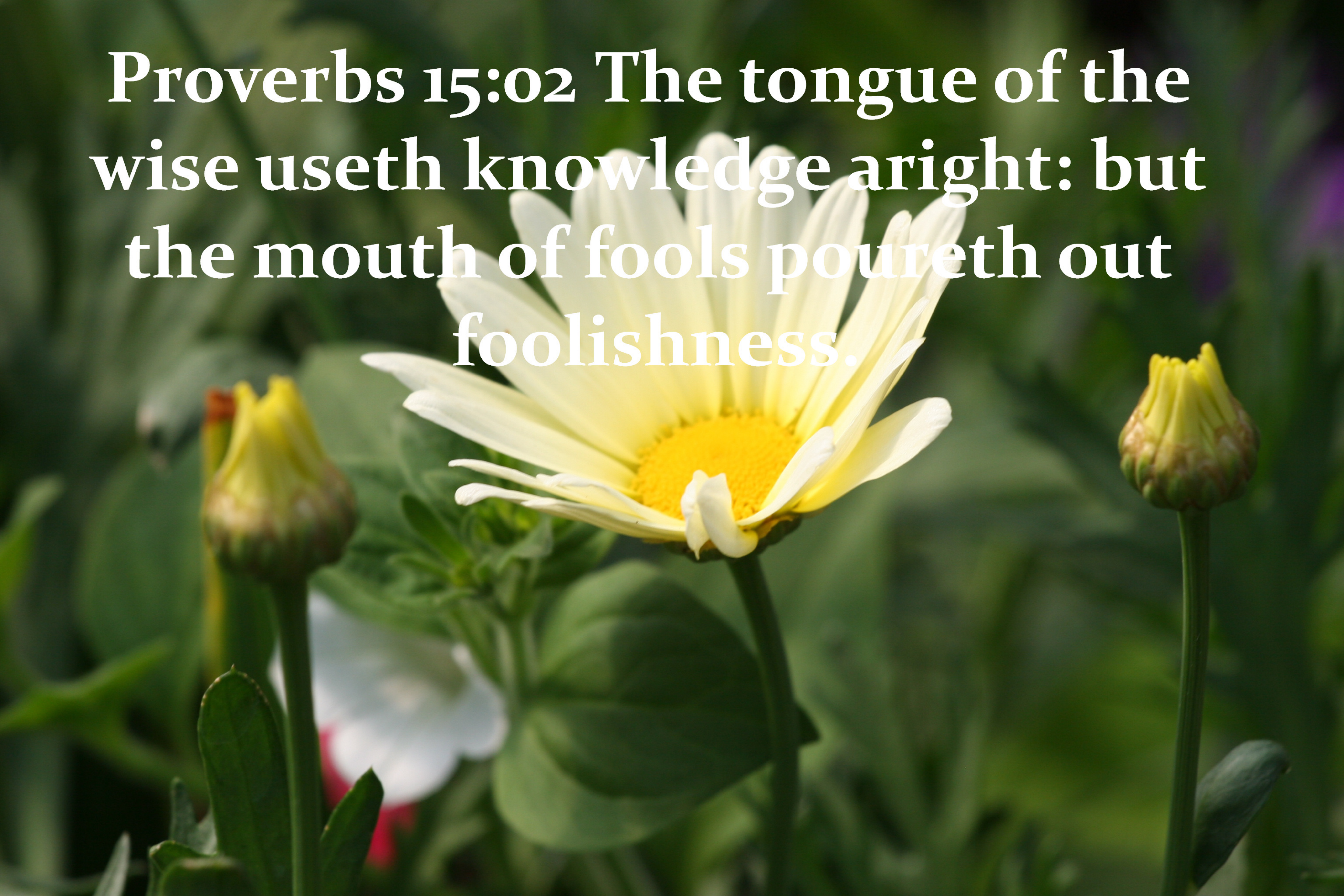
Psalm 50:23 Whoso offereth

steadfast with God.**




**Proverbs 15:02 The tongue of the
