





Leviticus 23:14 And ye shall eat

generations in all your dwellings.




**Joshua 05:11 And they did eat of the

corn in the selfsame day.**




**Ruth 02:14 And Boaz said unto her,

and was sufficed, and left.**




1st Samuel 17:17 And Jesse said

brethren;




