


# Word Study for --- VINES

the trees of their coasts.

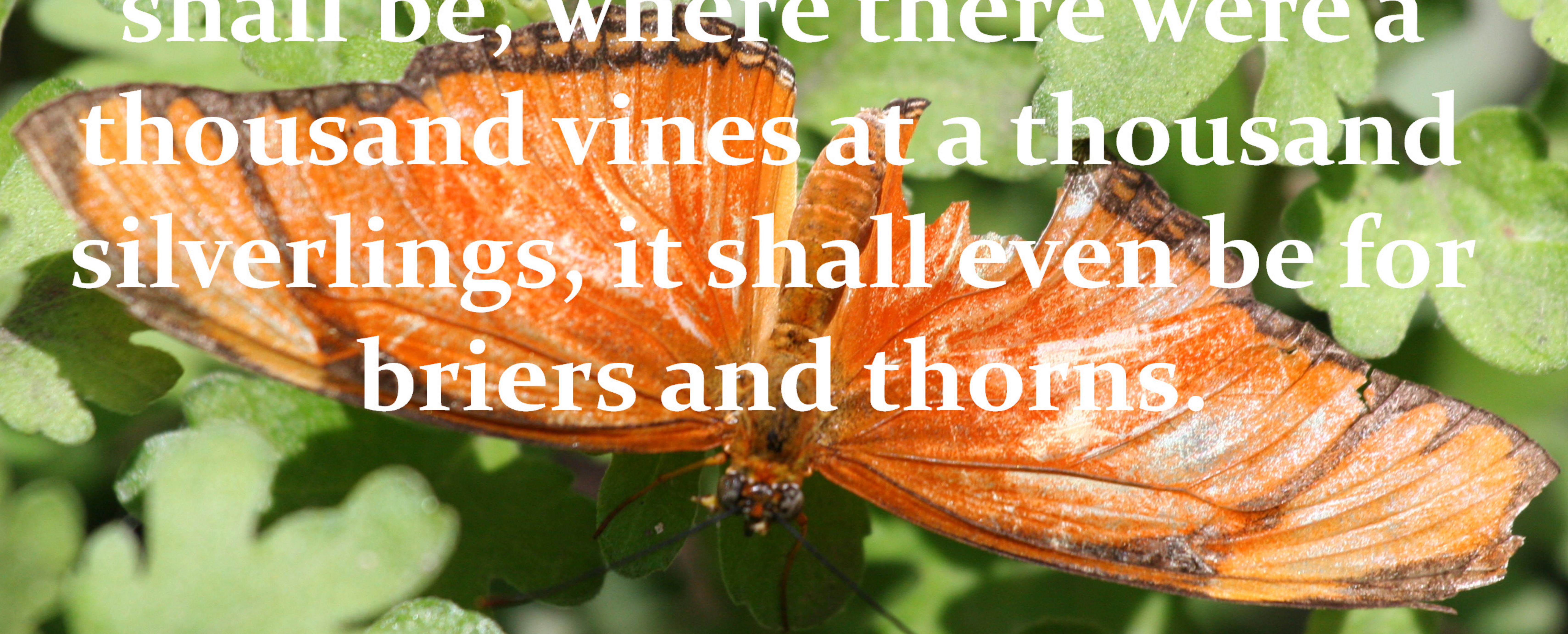
Song of Solomon 02:13 The fig tree

my fair one, and come away.





grapes.**









