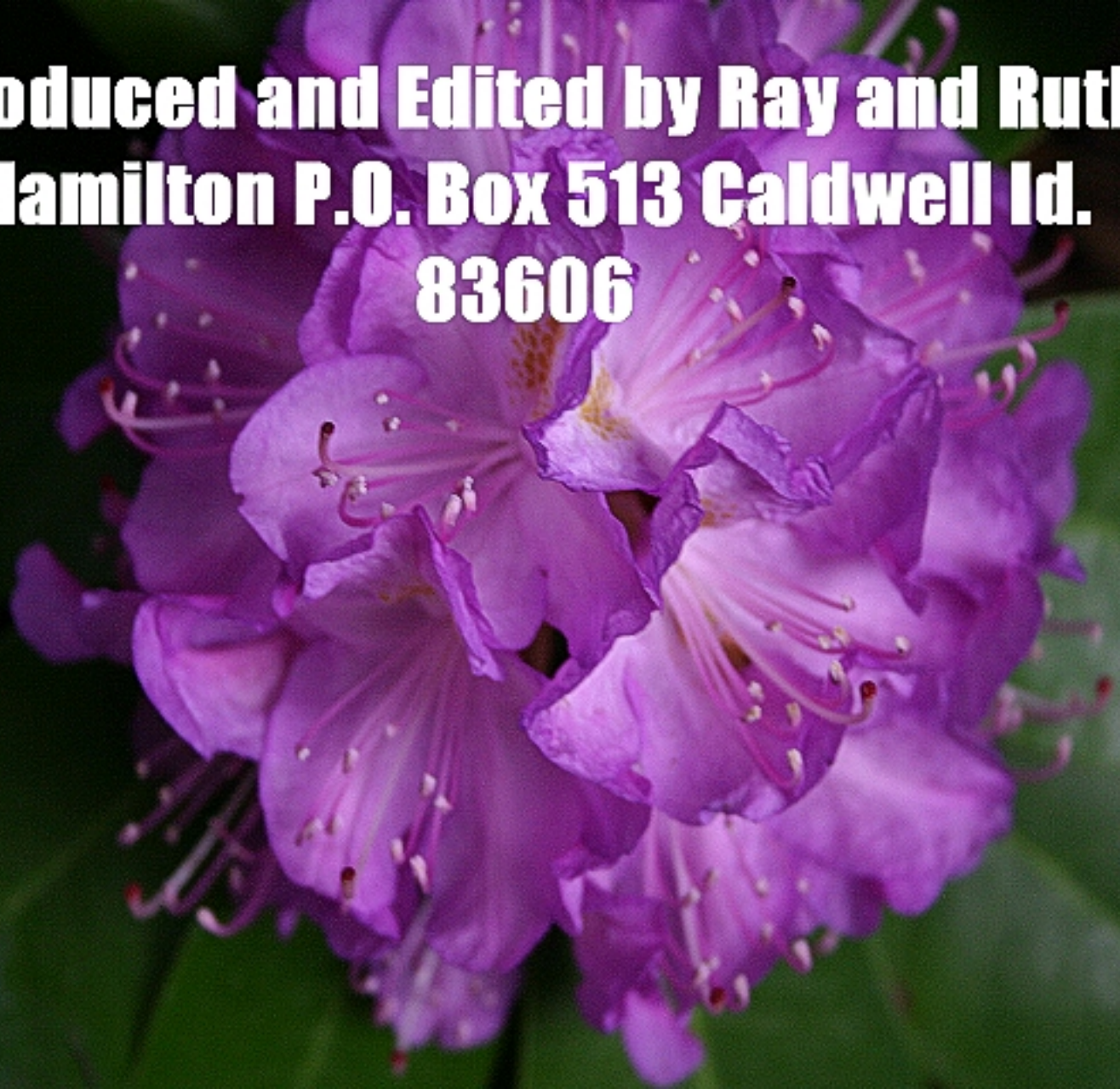








Zebulun?**




**Jud 04:08 And Barak said unto her, If

and Deborah went up with him.**




**Jud 04:12 And they showed Sisera that

to mount Tabor.**






