


**2Sa 20:01 And there happened to be there a man of Belial, whose name I was I Sheba, the son of Bichri, a Benjamite: and he blew a trumpet, and said, We have no part in David, neither have we inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to his tents, O Israel.**

**2Sa 20:02 So every man of Israel went up from after David, and followed Sheba the son of Bichri: but the men of Judah clave unto their king, from Jordan even to Jerusalem.**






**2Sa 20:07 And there went out after him
