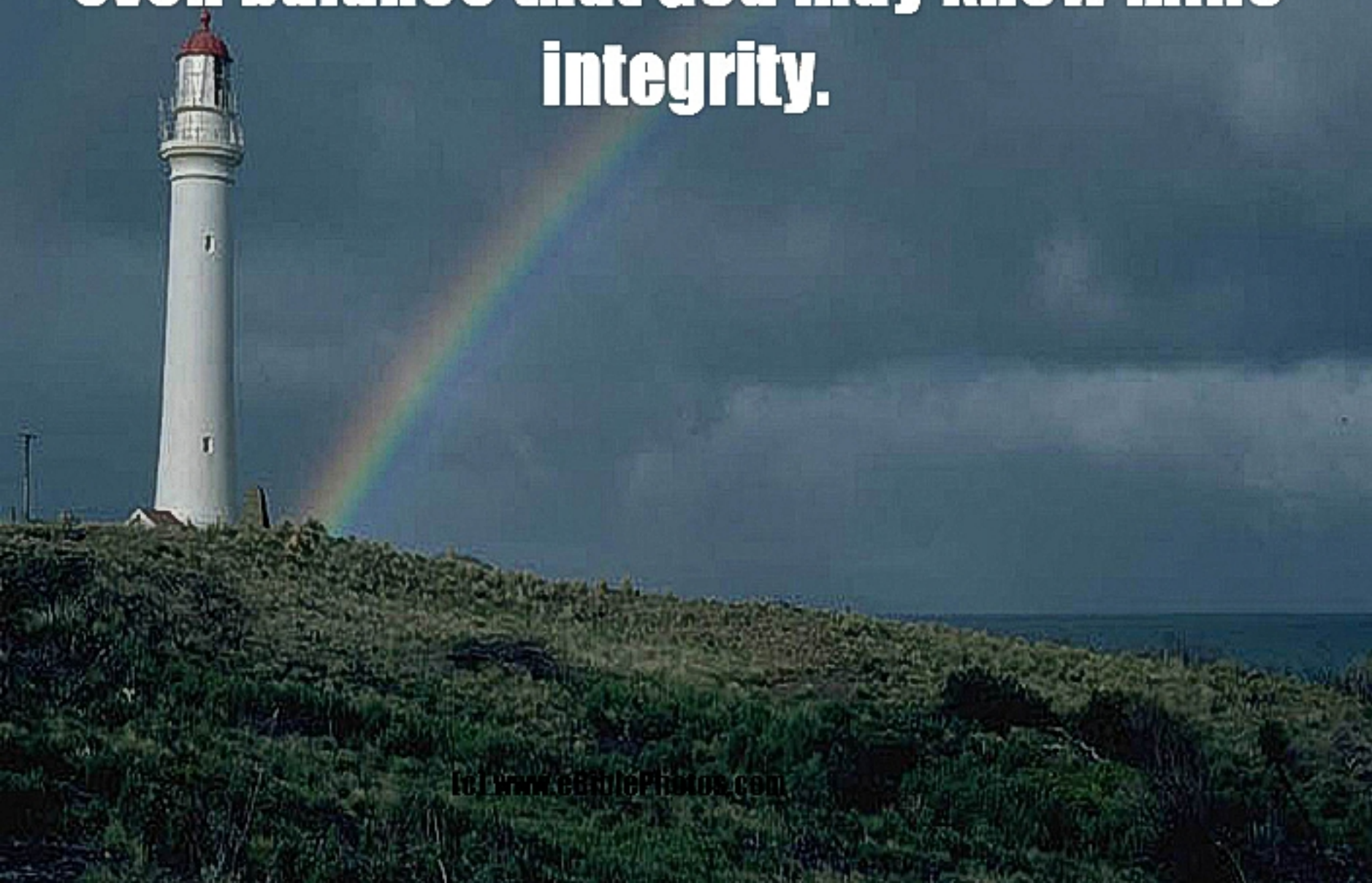

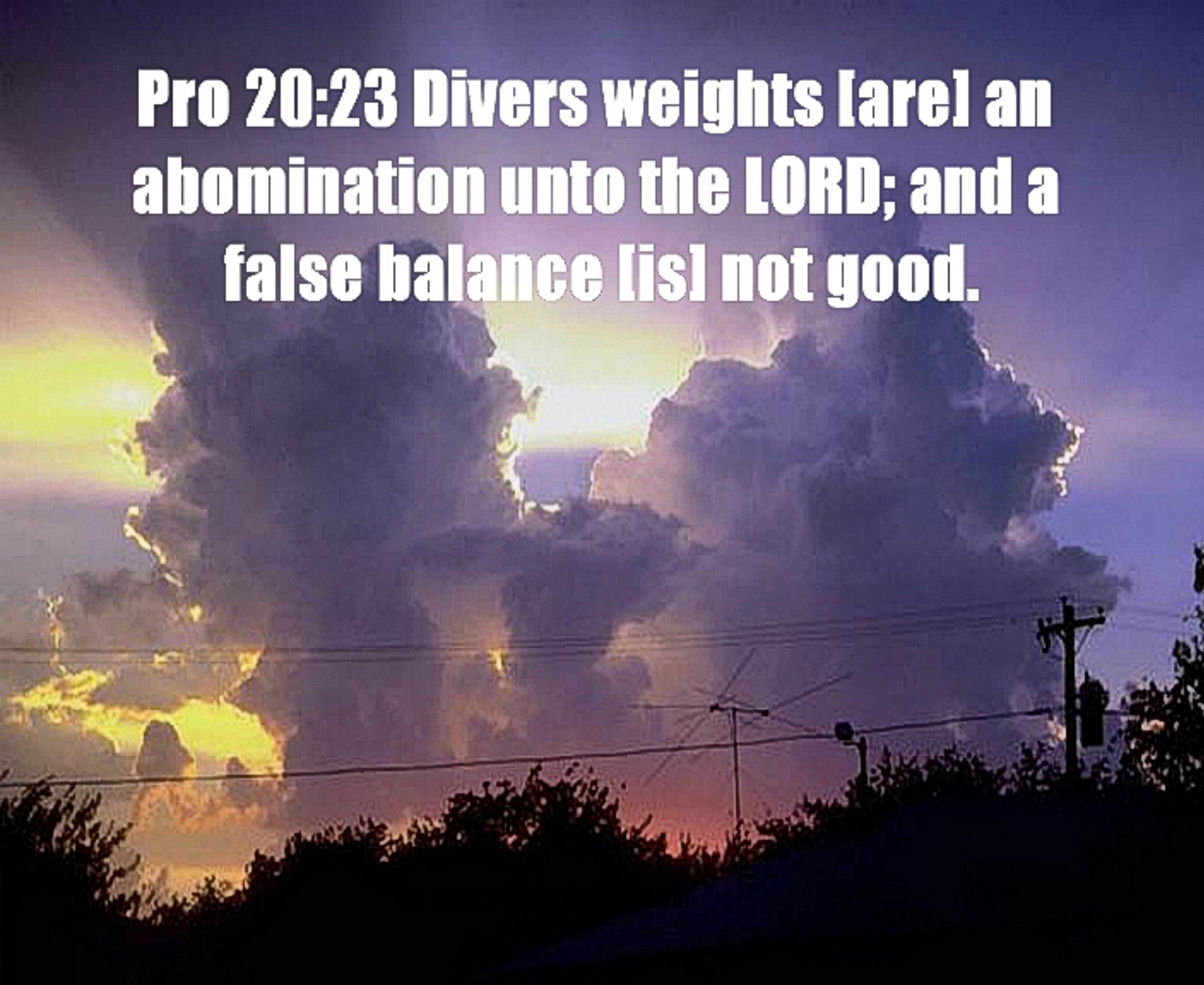





**Pro 11:01 A false balance is
