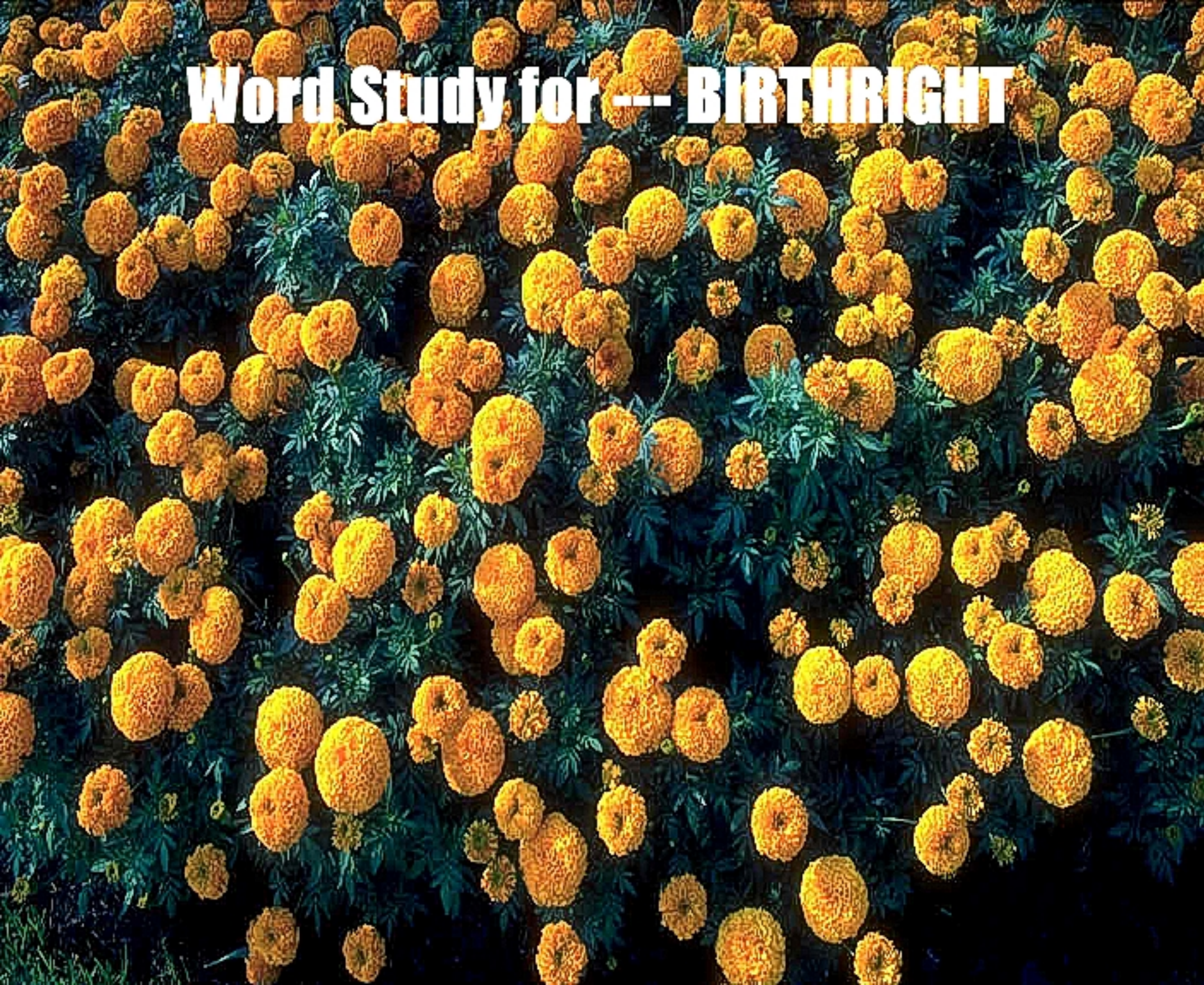



this birthright do to me?**


**Gen 25:33 And Jacob said, Swear to me
