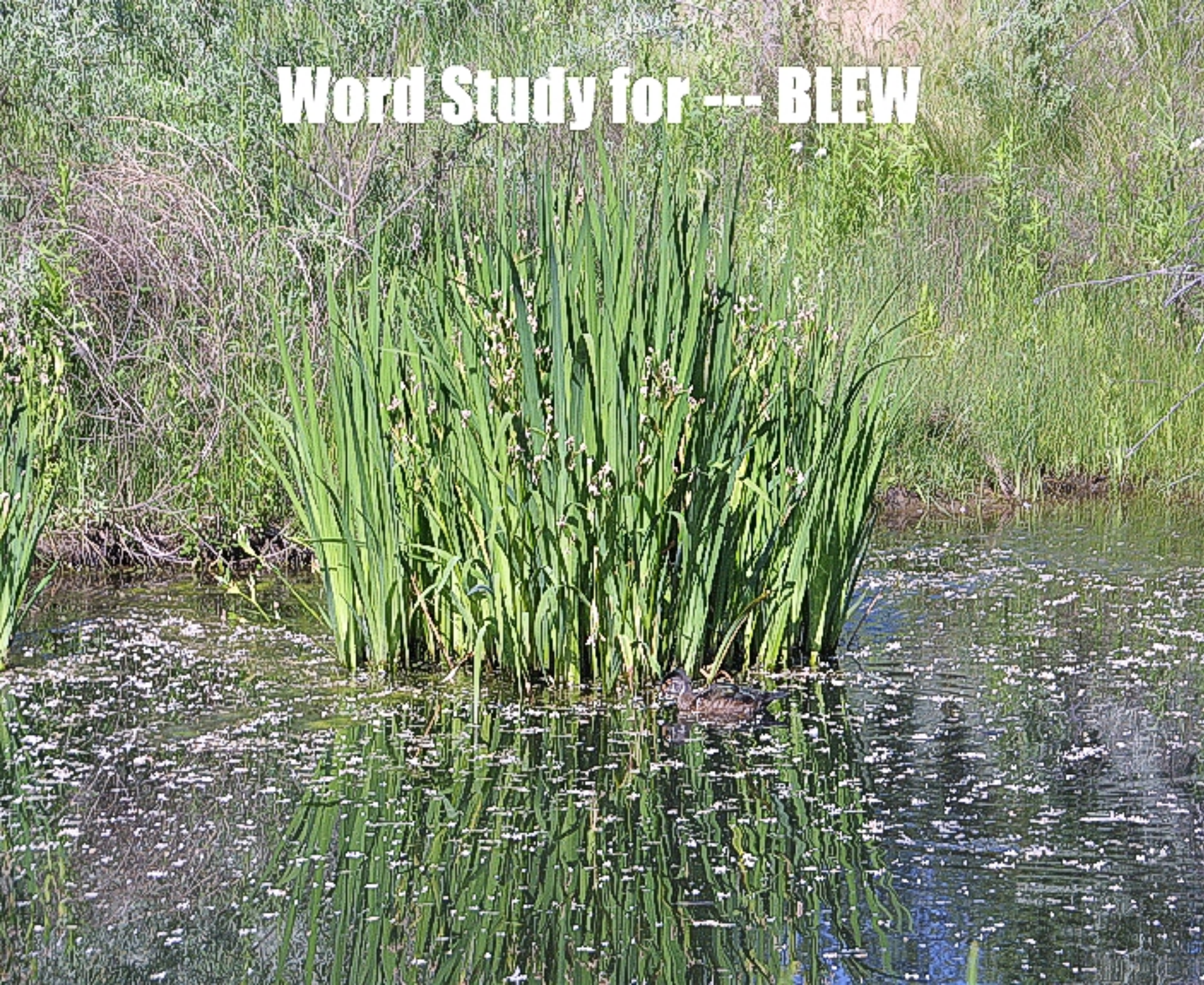



# Word Study for --- BLEW




**Jos 06:08 And it came to pass, when Joshua had spoken unto the people, that the seven priests bearing the seven trumpets of rams' horns passed on before the LORD, and blew with the trumpets: and the ark of the covenant of the LORD followed them.**



**Jos 06:09 And the armed men went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the rereward came after the ark, [the priests] going on, and blowing with the trumpets.**



**Jos 06:13 And seven priests bearing  
seven trumpets of rams' horns before  
the ark of the LORD went on  
continually, and blew with the  
trumpets: and the armed men went  
before them; but the rereward came


**Jud 06:34 But the spirit of the LORD

Hebrews hear.**


**2Sa 02:28 So Joab blew a trumpet, and


