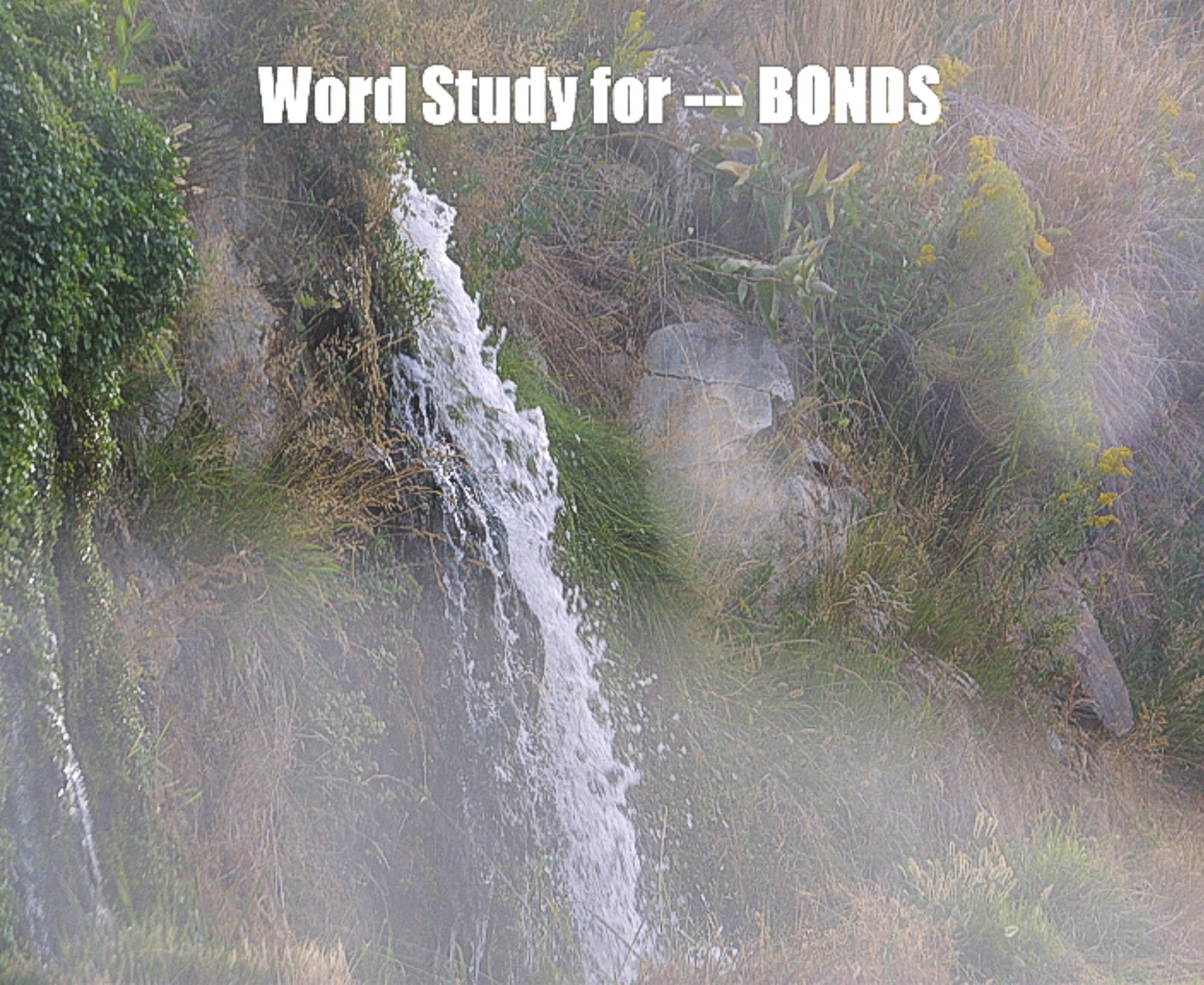



**Num 30:05 But if her father disallow her
in the day that he heareth; not any of
her vows, or of her bonds wherewith
she hath bound her soul, shall stand:
and the LORD shall forgive her, because
her father disallowed her.**

**Num 30:07 And her husband heard [it],

that he heard [it]: then her vows shall
