

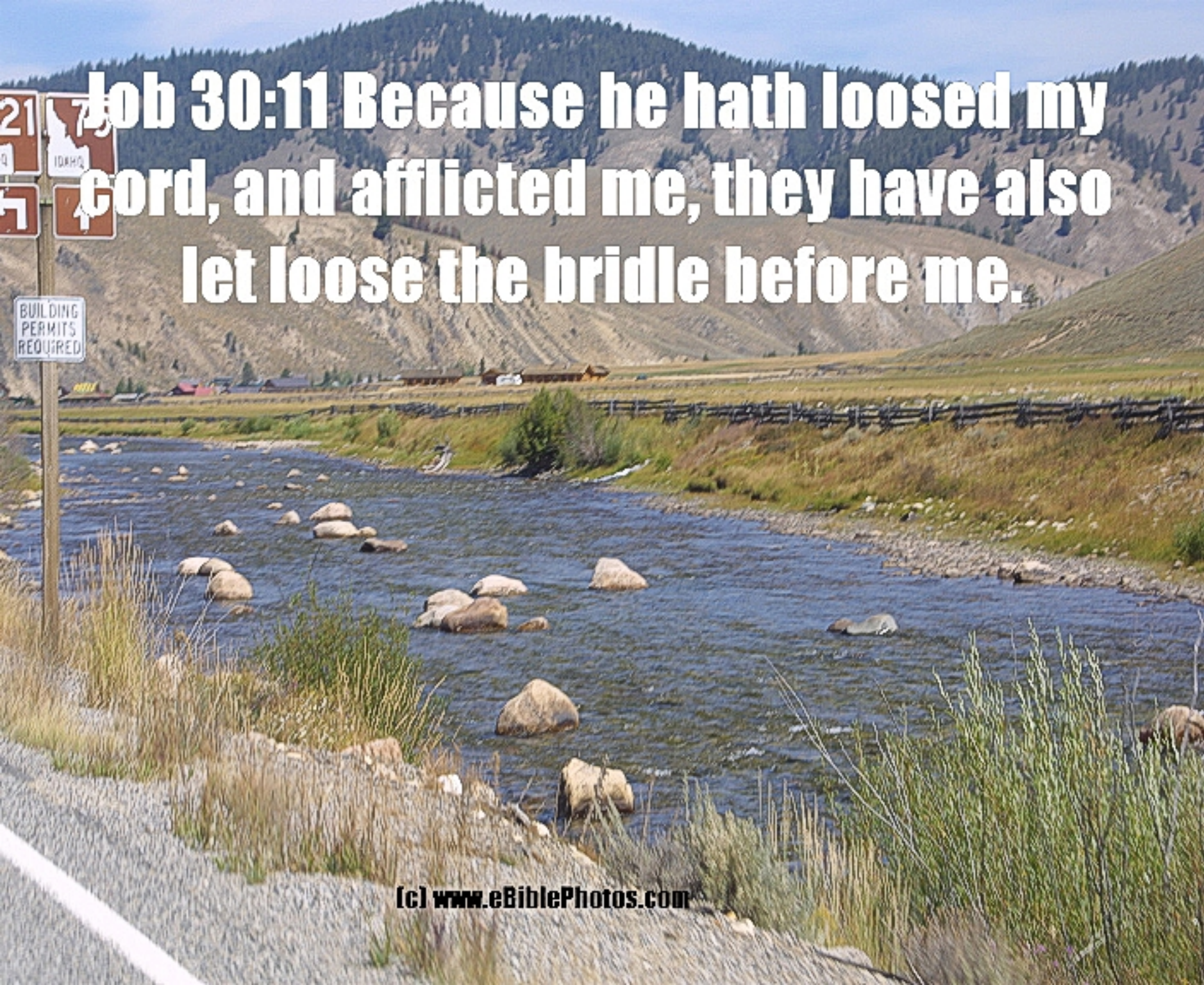






**2Ki 19:28 Because thy rage against me

which thou camest.**






**Job 30:11 Because he hath loosed my

let loose the bridle before me.**





come near unto thee.**






