

**Act 04:36 And Joses, who by the
apostles was surnamed Barnabas, [
which is, being interpreted, The son of
consolation,] a Levite, [and] of the
country of Cyprus,**

Act 11:19 Now they which were scattered abroad upon the persecution that arose about Stephen travelled as far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to none but unto the Jews only.

**Act 11:20 And some of them were men
of Cyprus and Cyrene, which, when
they were come to Antioch, spake unto
the Grecians, preaching the Lord
Jesus.**

**Act 13:04 So they, being sent forth by
the Holy Ghost, departed unto
Seleucia; and from thence they sailed
to Cyprus.**

Act 15:39 And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;
