

Word Study for -- CENSERS

**Num 04:14 And they shall put upon it all
the vessels thereof, wherewith they
minister about it, even the censers, the
fleshhooks, and the shovels, and the
basins, all the vessels of the altar; and
they shall spread upon it a covering of
badgers' skins, and put to the staves of
it.**

**Num 16:06 This do; Take you censers,
Korah, and all his company;**

Num 16:17 And take every man his censer, and put incense in them, and bring ye before the LORD every man his censer, two hundred and fifty censers; thou also, and Aaron, each of you his censer.

**Num 16:37 Speak unto Eleazar the son
of Aaron the priest, that he take up the
censers out of the burning, and
scatter thou the fire yonder; for they
are hallowed.**

Num 16:38 The censers of these sinners against their own souls, let them make them broad plates [for] a covering of the altar: for they offered them before the LORD, therefore they are hallowed: and they shall be a sign unto the children of Israel.

**Num 16:39 And Eleazar the priest took
the brazen censers, wherewith they
that were burnt had offered; and they
were made broad [plates for] a
covering of the altar:**

1Ki 07:50 And the bowls, and the snuffers, and the basins, and the spoons, and the censers [of] pure gold; and the hinges [of] gold, [both] for the doors of the inner house, the most holy [place, and] for the doors of the house, [to wit], of the temple.

**2Ch 04:22 And the snuffers, and the
basins, and the spoons, and the
censers, [of] pure gold: and the entry
of the house, the inner doors thereof
for the most holy [place], and the
doors of the house of the temple, [
were of] gold.**
