**Gen 31:32 With whomsoever thou  
findest thy gods, let him not live: before  
our brethren discern thou what is thine  
with me, and take it to thee. For Jacob  
knew not that Rachel had stolen them.**



**Gen 38:25 When she was brought forth,  
she sent to her father in law, saying, By  
the man, whose these are, am I with  
child: and she said, Discern, I pray thee,  
whose are these, the signet, and  
bracelets, and staff.**

**2Sa 14:17 Then thine handmaid said,  
The word of my lord the king shall now  
be comfortable: for as an angel of God,  
so [is] my lord the king to discern  
good and bad: therefore the LORD thy  
God will be with thee.**

**2Sa 19:35 I [am] this day fourscore  
years old: [and] can I discern between  
good and evil? can thy servant taste  
what I eat or what I drink? can I hear  
any more the voice of singing men and
