**Lev 04:20 And he shall do with the
bullock as he did with the bullock for a
sin offering, so shall he do with this:
and the priest shall make an atonement
for them, and it shall be forgiven them.**

**Lev 04:26 And he shall burn all his fat
upon the altar, as the fat of the
sacrifice of peace offerings: and the
priest shall make an atonement for
him as concerning his sin, and it shall
be forgiven him.**

**Lev 04:31 And he shall take away all
the fat thereof, as the fat is taken away
from off the sacrifice of peace
offerings; and the priest shall burn [it]


**Mar 04:12 That seeing they may see,

Luk 07:48 And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven.


